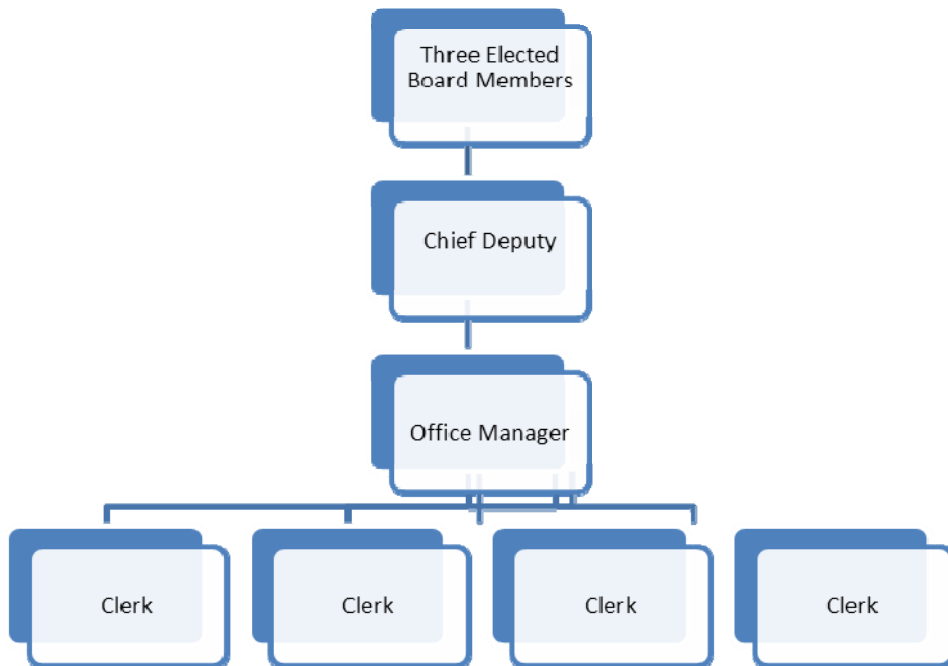


**ST CLAIR COUNTY OFFICE OF BOARD OF REVIEW  
ILLINOIS FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT POSTING  
PURSUANT TO 5 ILCS 140/1 *et. seq.***

The St. Clair County Board of Review consists of three elected members who have the power to hear and decide taxpayer complaints on the value or exempt status of property. That includes residential, commercial, industrial and condominium property as well as vacant land.

The St. Clair County Board of Review organizational structure is as follows and in 2017 includes, subject to change, three (3) board members, five (5) full time employees, and one (1) part-time hearing officer.



The St. Clair County Board of Review’s 2017 fiscal year budget is Three Hundred Twenty four Thousand and Five hundred Twenty seven Dollars (\$324,527)

The St. Clair County Board of Review’s operations and budget are overseen by the St. Clair County Board of Review and the St. Clair County Board Chairman.

## HOW TO REQUEST DOCUMENTS
