Owner: The Public Building Commission of St. Clair County, Illinois, as owner, operator and sponsor of MidAmerica St. Louis Airport (the Commission and St. Clair County collectively hereinafter referred to as the "Owner") hereby gives notice that Proposals will be received from qualified manufacturers and their distribution partners to provide Phone Systems equipment, installation and support. St. Clair County promotes equal opportunities and encourages participation by Disadvantage Business Enterprise firms to meet or make a good faith effort to meet the Airport's 7.0% DBE participation goals for this RFP.

Qualifications: Contractors submitting a Proposal must be qualified and/or authorized on Phone Systems proposed.

Time and Place of Submittal: Proposals will be received until **10:00 a.m. (local time) on March 9, 2020** in the Airport Department of Engineering & Planning. The Proposal must be submitted in accordance with all submission requirements set forth in the RFP. Facsimile or email submittals are not acceptable. Late submittals will not be accepted. Questions must be directed in writing as detailed in the RFP.

Pre-Proposal Conference: A pre-proposal conference and site visit is scheduled for 10:00 am on Thursday, February 27, 2020 at MidAmerica St. Louis Airport Passenger Terminal, 9656 Air Terminal Drive, Mascoutah, IL 62258.

RFP Documents: Contractors interested in submitting a Proposal may request the RFP from the Airport Department of Engineering & Planning by e-mail (alice.tejada@flymidamerica.com). The RFP and subsequent addenda (should there be any) will be distributed exclusively via e-mail to all plan holders.

Bid Bond: Proposals shall include a bid bond in such amount and with such surety, conditioned for the faithful performance of the contract. The bid bond should be written on AIA Document A310, Bid Bond, and the attorney-in-fact who executes the bond on behalf of the surety shall affix to the bond a certified and current copy of the power of attorney. Bond amount shall be 5%.

Contract Security: The Contractor to whom a Contract is awarded shall be required to furnish a Performance and Payment Bond for 100% of the Contract Price for the above Bonds, in accordance with the requirements of the Contract Documents.

Agreement: The Owner intends to execute an Agreement with the selected Contractor.

Submittal Rejection: This RFP does not obligate the Owner to execute an Agreement with any Contractor nor to pay any cost incurred in the preparation of any proposals submitted in response to this RFP. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all submittals, waive any informalities in submittals, or to accept a submittal which best serves the interests of the Owner.
