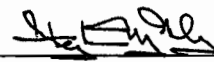

PROPOSITION C - METRO-EAST PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT

PROPOSITION FOR CREATION OF THE METRO-EAST PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT

Shall the Metro-East Park and Recreation District be created for the purpose of improving water quality; increasing park safety; providing neighborhood trails; improving, restoring and expanding parks; providing disabled and expanded public access to recreational areas; preserving natural lands for wildlife; and maintaining other recreation grounds within the boundaries of the Metro-East Park and Recreation District; and Shall St. Clair County join any other counties in the Metro-East region that approve the formation of the Metro-East Park and Recreation District, with the authority to impose a Metro-East Park and Recreation District Retailers' Occupation Tax at a rate of one-tenth of 1% upon all persons engaged in the business of selling tangible personal property at retail in the district on gross receipts on the sales made in the course of their business for the purposes stated above, with 50% of the revenue going to the Metro-East Park and Recreation District and 50% of the revenue returned to the county from which the tax was collected?

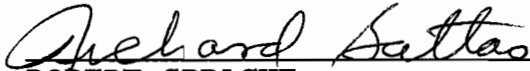
