

As Property Assessment Complaint Hearings begin for Tax Year 2020, we will continue to put our residents' health and safety first. As social distancing policies continue because of COVID-19, the Board of Review is asking those appealing their assessments to comply with one of the following options:

1. Mail in all evidence for an Evidence-Only Hearing. You will not be contacted, but all evidence will be thoroughly reviewed by the Board.
2. Mail in all evidence, and a Board Member will contact you via phone at your scheduled time. That date and time will be mailed to you.
3. Mail in evidence, and request a video conference at a scheduled time. That date and time will be mailed to you.

IF ONE OF THE ABOVE OPTIONS IS NOT SPECIFIED ON YOUR PTAX230 FORM, YOUR EVIDENCE WILL BE REVIEWED AND A DECISION WILL BE MADE WITHOUT CONTACT FROM A BOARD MEMBER.

Regardless of which option you choose for your hearing, you MUST submit all evidence pursuant to your property (appraisals, damage reports, photos, and comparable property information, etc., in the mail (postmarked), in locked/secure drop box outside the front of the County Building in the Circle Drive, or in our office on the Fifth Floor at least FIVE days before your scheduled hearing date.

*Please keep a copy of all evidence submitted for own records, as well, to review with a Board Member if you choose either the phone or video options. ***Evidence submitted to our office will not be returned.*
