 - a) District #1 shall include the Townships of Belleville, St. Clair, Shiloh Valley, Freeburg, New Athens and Fayetteville. General Assessment year for District #1 shall be 2016.
 - b) District #2 shall include the townships of Centreville, Sugar Loaf, Stookey, Smithton, Prairie DuLong and Millstadt. General Assessment year for District #2 shall be 2017.
 - c) District #3 shall include the townships of Canteen, O'Fallon, Lebanon, Mascoutah and Engelmann. General Assessment year for District #3 shall be 2018.
 - d) District #4 shall include the townships of East St. Louis, Stites (being designated Multiquad Township); Lenzburg, Marissa, and Caseyville, General Assessment year for District #4 shall be 2019.
 - Chairman requested that Jennifer Gomric-Minton explain her Resolution.
 - Mr. Craig Hubbard asked about the listing of counties name. Responded that she
 will check.

Upon motion by Mr. O'Donnell and seconded by Mr. Easterley, it was unanimously agreed to approve the following Resolutions:

- a) (St. Clair County) Resolution pursuant to duly published notices for bids for Section 14-00000-01-GM, which provides for the general repair and maintenance of various traffic signals throughout the County.
- b) (St. Clair County and Village of Shiloh) Resolution for improvement of Thouvenot Lane (CH95) and Hartman Lane (CH16) with the Village of Shiloh and Mac's Convenience Stores LLC (Circle K).
- c) (St. Clair County) Resolution accepting the low bid of \$62.36/ton from Cargill, Inc., Deicing Technology Business Unit for furnishing and delivering an estimated quantity of

9310 tons of rock salt for the 2015-2016 maintenance of County Highways, Road District Roads and Municipal Streets as included ikn Section 15-00000-00-GM.
