13 COMMENTS BY THE CHAIRMAN:

Chairman Kern noted that we had a spay and neuter clinic at the Animal Control Facility that went really well. It is a great value for the money and has caused a large decrease in the number of animals taken in at Animal Control and that is a good thing. This is a universally successful program for people throughout St. Clair County. Also, Chairman Kern noted that if you drive by the Dog Park at Animal Control, it is now seeded with straw and fertilizer being applied tomorrow. This is a park that has been built by volunteers, by prisoners, and by County workers. This park will enhance the ability to adopt out animals at the Adoption Center. Chairman Kern thanked Mr. Steve Reeb who chairs the Animal Services Committee and all of that Committee for a good job.

14 ANY OTHER PERTINENT BUSINESS:

Mr. Frank Heiligenstein inquired about the County Board not having a chance to vote on the \$\$50,000 worth of improvements at the Airport. Mr. Heiligenstein felt it should have been sent to the Board to be voted upon. Mr. Heiligenstein further commented that he would like a protocol from the Judiciary Committee for recognizing teams less than first place.

Chairman Kern responded stating that ninety percent of the money comes from the FAA and explained the reason for the replacement of lighting and doors for safety issues. Chairman Kern further noted the increase in passengers at MidAmerica Airport this year and that MidAmerica continues to pursue prospects every day.

Mr. Craig Hubbard inquired about Snowbirds that park at the Airport and leave their cars there for an extended period of time. Chairman Kern stated that motivating people to fly out of MidAmerica is a good thing and there is enough parking with the expansion to be able to handle the parking. If at some time in the future they need to look at the parking then that can be done. Chairman Kern stated that the more things that can be done to increase the flights and growing the passenger service is an important thing. Allegiant Airlines likes MidAmerica Airport because passengers like it. Chairman Kern stated to encourage people to buy tickets for the destinations offered at MidAmerica Airport.

Mr. Frank Heiligenstein inquired if there is anything to be done about NGA other than what is being done by the Chairman and the parties involved. Chairman Kern encouraged everyone to comment and send letters. The website is posted and we have some items of importance that have been brought up that are called talking points. Chairman Kern stated their opinions matter in this and also they should contact their legislators. Chairman Kern advised he met with our delegation in Washington this week and they are committed to try and make sure that the decision that is eventually made is the correct one. We believe the correct decision is to move to Scott Air Force Base.

Mr. Edwin Cockrell inquired as to the status of the study in East St. Louis for a stop for the High Speed Rail. Further, Mr. Cockrell stated that he feels it is appropriate to honor any recipients for first, second, or third place as they do in the Olympics. Chairman Kern advised that the Governor has put most capital projects on hold in the State and High Speed Rail is one of the largest projects in the State. Chairman Kern stated a lot of projects will be in a holding pattern until the budget is passed. The plan for the stop was completed and presented.
