HERBERT SIMMONS REQUESTED EMA REPORT OF ACTIVITIES FOR MARCH/APRIL 2016 BE PLACED ON FILE. HERB ALSO STATED FEMA TURNED DOWN THE APPEAL REQUEST FOR THE FLOOD BACK DECEMBER. IT WAS MOVED BY ROY MOSLEY, JR. AND SECONDED BY JERRY DINGES TO ACCEPT AND PLACE THE EMA REPORT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

MAJ. TOM KNAPP REPORTED THAT THE JAIL POPULATION AS OF 2:00 PM TODAY WAS 380 (JAIL CAPACITY IS 418). IT WAS MOVED BY ROY MOSLEY, JR. AND SECONDED BY DIXIE SEIBERT TO ACCEPT AND PLACE THE REPORT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

MAJ. KNAPP ALSO REPORTED THE SHERIFF WANTED TO KEEP US UP ON WHAT WE ARE DOING WITH THE PATROL FUNDS. THE PATROL IS SUPPLEMENTED FROM THREE AREAS LANDFILL, BAIL FUND AND PARKS. ON JANUARY 1, 2016 WE RECEIVED 246 ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLAINT CALLS

FROM PEOPLE WHICH LEAD TO 32 CASE REPORTS, DEPUTY YORK ISSUED 14 ENVIRONMENTAL REPORTS.

BAIL FUND SUPPLEMENT PATROL DOES AT LEAST ONE SECURITY CHECK A DAY IN THE COURTHOUSE. THIRD IS THE PARK PATROL SECURITY STATUS REPORTS 120 PATROL SECURITY CHECKS. IT WAS MOVED BY ROY MOSLEY, JR AND SECONDED BY DIXIE SEIBERT TO ACCEPT AND APPROVE THE MINUTES. MOTION CARRIED.

C. DAVID TIEDEMANN THANKED TOM KNAPP FOR PATROL REPORT.

CHAIRMAN MARK KERN STATED THE PARK PATROL WILL HELP ELEVATES ILLEGAL DUMPING.
