New Business:

James Jacquot, advised the Animal Services committee of the Ordinance Amending Chapter 3. It explains that Animal Services will be able to vaccinate on intake for distemper/parvo. It is on the condition that the various humane society's and welfare groups make the vaccines available. In the past we would only vaccinate the animals that we were keeping. We do vaccinate for rabies according to state law.

Motion by Mr. Trentman to approve the Ordinance Amending Chapter 3, second by Ms. Clark.

James Jacquot gave the statistics for November 2016.

James Jacquot, introduced Brent Toellner, he was formally one of the co-founders for Kansas City Pet Project. He is now with Best Friends, and asked Brent if he would like to say anything. Brent Toellner replied thank you, I'm with Best Friends Animal Society, and was previously with Kansas City Pet Project, which is an organization that helped Kansas City, Missouri animal shelter, go no-kill. Now I recently joined Best Friends about a month ago. If you don't know anything about Best Friends, we are the only national organization fully dedicated to ending the killing of true companion animals in our shelters. I just wanted to come tonight, and applaud everyone in this room for the no-kill resolution. I think it is a great step you are taking in the process of making the statement and showing you do want to be a no-kill community in St. Clair. I want to applaud you on that, and on the work that has been done to get to this point, and the work that lies ahead. Also the amending to the ordinance is a great addition. Good job everyone, and thank you for letting me be here watch and witness.

Open comments:

(All of the following questions were directed to James Jacquot, Director of Animal Services, unless indicated.)

Q: Unidentified: I have a question on the ordinance that you just passed. It says you will vaccinate upon intake to healthy animals. What is the time frame?

A: Will be doing that immediately. We will try to do it within the first twenty-four hours.

Q: Unidentified: You say a healthy dog or pet, who will decide on the health.

A: If we have a question about the health we will run it by the vet before we vaccinate.



Steve Reeb informed all in attendance that the Ordinance Amending Chapter 3, will go in front of the full county board tonight after it passes the Judiciary. We will also have the no-kill resolution tonight on the full county board meeting.
