Environment Committee Report, January 19, 2016

From EDG meeting, January 12, 2016

- 40 SCCSD Environmental contacts made during the month of December
 - 87 non-traffic citations by SCCSD in 2015
 - 522 Environmental calls for service by SCCSD in 2015
 - 1 Open Dump site opened
 - 1 Open Dump site closed
 - 3 Landfill Inspections conducted
 - 1 Compost Site Inspection conducted
 - 1 Incinerator Inspection conducted
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- Approved EDG Schedule passed out to EDG Committee
 - Earth Day scheduled for April 20, 2016
 - Provided SCC EMA educational information on flooding including; tetanus shots, safety, guidelines from IEPA for debris removal and mold and flood clean-up guidelines for homeowners.
 - Staff released the following information to the media, cities, townships and/or our website: Flood Clean-Up Press Release (12/29/15), What to do if your Private Well was Flooded Press Release (01/05/16) and "After the Flood" educational brochure from IDPH.
 - Staff fielded approximately 20 calls to public on flooding to discuss items such as: mold, clean-up of property and water well testing.
 - IEPA issued a letter to WMI at end of December allowing mixed loads to be accepted with reasonable effort to segregate out the white goods and e-waste.
 - Clean Sweep removed 19.22 tons of waste from St. Clair County sites in December.
 - 44 landfill inspections, consultations, complaint inspections, complaint rechecks and follow-up inspections
