TOM KNAPP REPORTED THAT THE JAIL POPULATION AS OF 2:00PM THIS AFTERNOON WAS 408 THE RATE OF CAPACITY IS 418.

TOM KNAPP ALSO REPORTED JAIL ACTIVITY FOR AUGUST 2016, 615 INMATES ADMITTED 155 WHERE FEMALES, 460 MALES AND OF THE 247 MISDEMEANORS 189 FELONS, 7 FEDERAL CASES AND A HOST ANCILLARY CHARGES.

JAIL REPORT ON THE PATROL SIDE FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST TRAFFIC STOPS 234, 124 CITATIONS ISSUED, 23 FELONY ARREST, 43 MISDEMEANORS ARREST. 137 COURTHOUSE

CHECKS, 609 PARKS PATROLS AND ENVIRONMENTAL OFFICERS MADE 61 CONTACTS

JERRY DINGES STATED SO CRIME IS DOWN BECAUSE OF YOUR CHECKS.

MARK KERN REPLIED YES AND VANDALISM IS DOWN.
