Effective January 1, 2017 - December 31, 2018

AGREEMENT between St. Clair County and Laborer's International Union of North America, AFL-CIG, Local Union 100

#### PREAMBLE

This Agreement entered into by St. Clair County and the St. Clair County Health Department, Illinois, hereinafter referred to as "EMPLOYER" (or "DEPARTMENT"), and Laborer's International Union of North America, AFL-CIG, Local Union 100 hereinafter referred to as "UNION", supersedes and cancels any and all previous agreements, whether written or verbal, between Employer and Union or any individual, and concludes all collective bargaining negotiations for the term of this Agreement, except as specifically provided herein.

Employer and Union mutually agree that their objective is to set forth herein their entire agreement covering rates of pay and wages, hours of employment, and other conditions of employment; to promote the efficiency and productivity of employees in the St. Clair County Health Department; and to provide for prompt and fair settlement of grievances without any work stoppages which interfere with the operation of the St. Clair County Health Department. It is Employer's and Union's desire to provide the people of St. Clair County, Illinois, with the highest-quality service by mutual agreement through good-faith people in the state of the good-faith negotiations.

The parties acknowledge that during the negotiations which resulted in this Agreement, each had the unlimited right and opportunity to make demands and proposals with respect to any subject or matter not removed by law from the area of collective bargaining, and that the understandings and agreements arrived at by the parties after the exercise of that right and opportunity are set forth in this Agreement. Therefore, Employer and Union, for the duration of this Agreement, each voluntarily and unqualifiedly waives the right, and each agrees that the other shall not be obligated to bargain collectively with respect to any subject or matter referred to or covered in this Agreement, including the impact of Employer's exercise of its rights as set forth herein on salaries, fringe benefits, or terms and conditions of employment.
