Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mr. Trentman.

New Business:

Jim Jacquot informed the committee members of his meeting with Dr. Lawler, Dr. Kohn, and Dr. Lee, professor's at SIU Edwardsville. They will be submitting a proposal for a research project on the county's "Community Cat Program" as it relates to TNR. Dr. Lee envisions the project to include their undergrads and graduate students collecting data. Dr. Kohn and Dr. Lee will be looking into possibly creating an accredited curriculum for this research project. Approval of this project could be a tremendous asset to what we are trying to accomplish.

The question was asked when they hope to have the approval by. Jim Jacquot replied by August. They want it before the school year. They want to start it with the new school year.

Another question asked will it help in funding the TNR? Jim replied, as for as all the counting, I don't think they will ever get into funding on spay and neuters, but a lot of the things that time wise you guys would have to do, they would be able to take over that, which would free up to actually do the TNR.

Robert Trentman asked how the new dog park is, are we using it across the street. Jim Jacquot replied that we have water hocked up now, so that has helped a lot. We are starting to use it and starting to water the trees.

Robert Trentman said that the SCCAWA wanted to come up with a list of events over the summer that we could take some of the dogs to. These would be events that the Adoption Center does not know about. We think it would be worthwhile and get some exposure with the community, so they are going to come up with some events. Robert Trentman asked about our volunteers being trained to take animals to events. Jim Jacquot said no. They only bath, brush, and play with the animals.

Steve Gomric asked what the goal, of these events is. SCCAWA answered to get dogs adopted and exposure for the dogs. Robert Trentman said the more animals that get adopted the more animals that become safe. James Jacquot reminded everyone that these animals going to these events, does back up, in reverse of what you want. By the time you get them fixed, and vaccinated and everything else, we have to do that in advance. That means that the animals aren't moving, and the SCCAWA has complained in the past with our other events. Once they finish the quarantine and we get them ready for an event it's at least five days after surgery before we would take them to an event. Robert Trentman asked what is going on in Centerville as for as buying a building. Jim Jacquot said he hasn't talked to Mark Kern about that at all. Also, Robert Trentman asked if the dogs are getting the bones. Jim Jacquot replied that we did, and had a

sewage problem already, it got in the drain, and clogged up our sewers. It is a problem; we need bigger bones so they can't get in the drains.

Robert Trentman asked if all of the kennels in the adoption center are full. Jim Jacquot replied yes, and today we had the least amount of animals on the animal control side in quite a while.

The numbers for May 2017, live release is at 71%. It is going to be tough to get under that number during the summer, with volume all the time.
