Call to Order:

Chairman Ken Sharkey called the Committee to order at 6:00 p.m. and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

New Business (Airport Director's Report, information only):

Mr. Beach stated that Mr. Cantwell was unable to attend but provided handouts which Mr. Beach distributed. The handouts showed about 150,000 passengers in 2016 with a projected 2017 volume of 180,000 to 200,000 passengers; 500,000 gallons of Jet A was sold in the first quarter of 2017; and that there will be soon 25 flights weekly and/or 3 daily.
