ROLL CALL FOR THE November 27, 2017 PUBLIC SAFETY MEETING.

JERRY DINGES ASKED IF THERE WERE ANY COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC REGARDING THE MEETINGS AGENDA. NO COMMENTS MADE.

IT WAS MOVED BY ROY MOSLEY, JR. AND SECONDED BY MICHAEL O'DONNELL TO APPROVE THE November 27, 2017 MINUTES. MOTION CARRIED.

FRANK BERGMAN READ ALL THE CORRESPONDENCE FOR THE MONTH. IT WAS MOVED BY PAUL SEIBERT AND SECONDED BY MICHAEL O'DONNELL TO ACCEPT AND PLACE ON FILE ALL CORRESPONDENCE AND REPORTS. MOTION CARRIED.

HERBERT SIMMONS READ HIS EMA REPORT OF ACTIVITIES FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER/NOVEMBER 2017. THERE WAS NO QUESTIONS OR COMMENTS. IT WAS MOVED BY PAUL SEIBERT AND SECONDED BY STEVE GOMRIC TO ACCEPT THE EMA REPORT AND PLACE IT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

TOM KNAPP REPORTED FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER THE JAILS AVERAGE DAILY POPULATION WAS 405, RATE OF CAPACITY IS 418. WE HAD FOUR DAYS OUT OF THE MONTH WITH ONE OR TWO OVER AND ONE DAY WE HAD SIXTEEN OVER FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER. THE JAIL HAD 627 INMATES' THE AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY WAS FIVE DAYS.

WE HAD 163 FEMLES, 464 MALES, 215 MISDEMEANORS, 5 FELONS 5 FEDERALS AND 94 FUGITIVES. THE PATROL DIVISION FOR THE MONTH OCTOBER WE MADE 473 TRAFFIC STOPS ISSUED 268 CITATIONS, 17 FELLON ARREST, 27 MISDEMEANOR ARREST AND 42 WARRANT ARREST. 264 COURTHOUSE CHECKS, 516 PARK PATROLS OVERALL 7089 POINTS OF CONTACT WITH THE GENERAL PUBLIC. ENVIRONMENTALLY 100 CONTACTS WAS MADE BY THE ENVIORNMENTAL OFFICER WITH 10 CIATIATIONS ISSUED.

THE ACCIDENT REVIEW BOARD GOT TOGETHER REVIEWED 5 OR 6 MONTHS OF ACCIDENT REPORTS. WE ARE HAPPY TO REPORT THEY HAD ONLY 32 ACCIDENTS. OUT OF THOSE ONLY 3 WAS CHARGEABLE AND 1 NONCHARGEABLE. IT WAS MOVED BY STEVE GOMRIC AND SECOND BY PAUL SEIBERT TO ACCEPT HIS REPORT AND PLACE IT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

FRANK BERGMAN REPORTED THE ACCIDENT REPORTS FOR NOVEMBER 2017. THERE WAS ONE CORRECTION THERE WAS A TYPO IN THE REPORT IT SHOULD HAVE BEEN 34 DAYS OFF INSTEAD OF 24. THERE BEING NO QUESTIONS, IT WAS MOVED BY PAUL SEIBERT AND SECONDED BY ROY MOSLEY TO ACCEPT HIS REPORT AND PLACE IT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, IT WAS MOVED BY ROY MOSLEY, JR. AND SECONDED BY STEVE GOMRIC TO ADJOURN. MOTION CARRIED.
