ORDINANCE NO. _18-1187_

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 40 - (ZONING ORDINANCE) OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE COUNTY OF ST. CLAIR, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, St. Clair County, Illinois, has adopted a Zoning Code (Chapter 40) which regulates and guides the development and the use of land in unincorporated St. Clair County, Illinois;

WHEREAS, the St. Clair County Zoning Code requires periodic review and revisions to its provisions for needed updates and/or compliance with State law;

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the St. Clair County Zoning Administrator and the St. Clair County Zoning Board of Appeals that it is necessary and in the best interests of the public and the citizens of St. Clair County to update and amend the St. Clair County Zoning Code (Chapter 40) to regulate Solar Energy Systems in St. Clair County, Illinois;

WHEREAS, the St. Clair County Zoning Administrator has prepared certain text amendments to Chapter 40 applicable to Solar Energy Systems - See Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by

WHEREAS, the St. Clair County Zoning Administrator on behalf of St. Clair County, petitioned the St. Clair County Zoning Board of Appeals to consider said text amendments to the St. Clair County Zoning Code;

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public hearing was held in the County Board Room, 5th Floor, St. Clair County Building, #10 Public Square, Belleville, Illinois, on April 9, 2018, at 7:40 p.m., before the St. Clair County Zoning Board of Appeals to consider the Zoning Administrator's petition 2018-01-TA pertaining to text amendments to certain sections of the Zoning Code for Solar Energy Systems; and

WHEREAS, the St. Clair County Zoning Board of Appeals, after reviewing the text amendments, considering the Zoning Administrator's testimony, a summary of the proposed amendments, comments from those in attendance, voted 5-0 to recommend the adoption of the proposed text amendments to the St. Clair County Board, and has submitted its Advisory Report; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of St. Clair County, Illinois, that:

SECTION I: Recitals. The facts and statements contained in the foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as findings of the County Board of St. Clair County.

SECTION II: Amendment to Revised Code. The St. Clair County Revised Code of Ordinances - Chapter 40 (Zoning Ordinance) is hereby amended to read as follows:

("SEE EXHIBIT A")

SECTION III: Inconsistent Ordinances Repealed. All Ordinances or parts of other Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance shall be to the extent of the conflict be, and are hereby

repealed, provided that nothing herein shall in any way excuse or prevent prosecution of any previous or existing violation of any Ordinance superseded hereby.

SECTION IV: Saving Clause. Nothing in this Ordinance hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed by this Ordinance, nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION V: Effective. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

WHEREAS, the Southwestern Illinois Development Authority Act, 70 ILCS 520/1 et seq., as amended, authorizes Southwestern Illinois Development Authority (hereinafter referred to as "SWIDA") by ordinance to designate prior to January 1, 2000, a portion of the territorial jurisdiction of SWIDA located in the Townships of O'Fallon, Lebanon, Mascoutah, and Shiloh Valley of the County of St. Clair for certification as an Enterprise Zone under the Illinois Enterprise Zone Act in addition to any other Enterprise Zones which may be created under that Act. The area shall have all the privileges and rights of an Enterprise Zone, under the Illinois Enterprise Zone Act, but shall not be counted in determining the number of Enterprise Zones to be created in any year under that Act;

WHEREAS, the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of St. Clair County, and the Municipalities of Lebanon, Mascoutah, O'Fallon, and Shiloh are dependent, in part, upon a healthy private sector in St. Clair County;

WHEREAS, the development, growth, and expansion of the private sector requires a cooperative and continuous partnership between government and the private sector;

WHEREAS, there are certain areas in the County that need the particular attention of government, business, and labor to attract private sector investment and directly aid the entire County and the residents thereof;

WHEREAS, a number of residents within the incorporated municipalities of Lebanon, Mascoutah, O'Fallon, Shiloh, and adjacent areas of unincorporated St. Clair County, for several years have suffered pervasive unemployment and economic distress, related to a variety of economic factors negatively affecting the incorporated and unincorporated areas mentioned above;

WHEREAS, the duly constituted legislative bodies of St. Clair County, and the Municipalities of Lebanon, Mascoutah, O'Fallon, and Shiloh are cognizant of the distressed conditions existing within this area and are desirous of alleviating these distressed conditions;

WHEREAS, St. Clair County, and the Municipalities of Lebanon, Mascoutah, O'Fallon; and Shiloh have indicated their willingness and desire to cooperate in designating portions of their municipalities and unincorporated area in St. Clair County as an Enterprise Zone;

WHEREAS, on November 29, 1999, St. Clair County Board passed a Resolution entitled "A Resolution establishing an Enterprise Zone consisting of adjacent area within the County of St. Clair, City of Lebanon, City of Mascoutah, City of O'Fallon, and Village of Shiloh, subject to approval by the Southwestern Illinois Development Authority and by Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, and approving and authorizing the execution of an Intergovernmental Agreement" being Resolution No. 268-99-R;

WHEREAS, with the further expansion of the enterprise zone, the new additions will receive all the State and local amenities provided by the present enterprise zone;
