ROLL CALL FOR THE APRIL 30, 2018 PUBLIC SAFETY MEETING.

THERE WERE NO COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC REGARDING THE MEETINGS AGENDA.

IT WAS MOVED BY ROY MOSLEY, JR. AND SECONDED BY STEVE GOMRIC TO APPROVE THE MARCH 2018 MINUTES. MOTION CARRIED.

FRANK BERGMAN READ ALL THE CORRESPONDENCE FOR THE MONTH. IT WAS MOVED BY PAUL SEIBERT AND SECONDED BY JOAN MCINTOSH TO ACCEPT AND PLACE ON FILE ALL CORRESPONDENCE AND REPORTS. MOTION CARRIED.

HERBERT SIMMONS WAS ABSENT FROM THE MEETING. THERE WHERE NO COMMENTS OR **OUESTIONS REGARDING THE MARCH 26, 2018 E.M.A. REPORT. IT WAS MOVED BY ROY** MOSLEY, JR. AND SECONDED BY JOAN MCINTOSH TO ACCEPT THE EMA REPORT AND PLACE IT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

TOM KNAPP REPORTED THE POPULATIONS DOC RATE OF CAPACITY WAS 418 FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, AVERAGE DAILY POPULATION WAS 301. THE JAIL BOOKED 692, OLDEST PERSON WAS 69, 174 FEMALES, 518 MALES, 222 MISDEMEANORS 253 FELONS, 4 FEDERALS, 115 FUGITIVES. ON THE PATROL SIDE OF THINGS FOR MARCH, 516 TRAFFIC STOPS, ISSUED 276 CITATIONS, 40 FELONY ARREST, 33 MISDEMEANOR ARREST, 33 WARRANT ARREST. THERE WHERE 338 COURTHOUSE STATUS CHECKS, 594 PARK PATROLS AND 8,816 POINT OF CONTACT WITH GENERAL PUBLIC.

ON THE ROAD SIDE FOR THE FIRST QUARTER OF 2018 WE HAD 1,264 TRAFFIC STOPS, ISSUED 773 CITATIONS, 65 FELONY ARRESTS, 84 MISDEAMEANOR ARRESTS, AND 98 WARRANT ARRESTS WITH AN OVERALL TOTAL 23,069 POINT OF CONTACT WITH THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

THERE WHERE 78 ENVIORNMENTAL CONTACTS MADE, 8 ENVIORNMENTAL RELATED CITATIONS ISSUED, 10 VIOLATION NOTICES ISSUED.

THE ACCIDENT REVIEW BOARD MET TO REVIEW THE FIRST QUARTER ACCIDENTS THERE WHERE 8 AND 2 WHERE FOUND CHARGABLE REPRIMANDS WHERE ISSUED. THERE BEING NO QUESTIONS, IT WAS MOVED BY MICHEAL O'DONNELL AND SECONDED BY JOAN MCINTOSH TO ACCEPT HIS REPORT AND PLACE IT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

FRANK BERGMAN REVIEW OF THE ACCIDENT REPORT AND STATED THERE WAS A COUPLE OF WINDSHIELDS BROKEN AND A BACKING INTO A POLE. THERE BEING NO QUESTIONS, IT WAS MOVED BY PAUL SIEBERT AND SECONDED BY ROY MOSLEY, JR. TO ACCEPT THE ACCIDENT REPORT AND PLACE ON FILE.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, IT WAS MOVED BY ROY MOSLEY, JR. AND SECONDED BY MICHAEL O'DONNELL TO ADJOURN, MOTION CARRIED.
