**Motorola Project Update:**Director Simmons and staff continue to work with Motorola as it relates to the relocation of the Norfolk Southern Railroad Tower to CENCOM West. Tower staff began the equipment mapping process on December 12, 2018.

**Monthly 9-1-1 Call Statistics:** Director Simmons referred to the monthly call stats for the Board to review.

**PSAP Consolidation Update:**The Directorinformed the Board that the December meeting of the Statewide 9-1-1 Advisory Board was cancelled and the Administrative Law Judge Hearing for Madison County which was supposed to be held on December 11, 2018, has been postponed until the new year.
