The usual completion of projects, requests for extensions and payment of invoices for Cycle 24 have been processed during the last month. The contract deadline for Cycle 25 is December 1, 2018. To date, 18 contracts for Cycle 25 have been returned and processed.

# 2017 Park Projects:

Requests for payments have been processed during the last month on various projects.
