IT WAS MOVED BY KEVIN DAWSON AND SECONDED BY ROY MOSLEY, JR. TO APPROVE THE DECEMBER 18, 2017 MINUTES. MOTION CARRIED.

FRANK BERGMAN READ ALL THE CORRESPONDENCE FOR THE MONTH. IT WAS MOVED BY JOAN MCINTOSH AND SECONDED BY PAUL SEIBERT TO ACCEPT AND PLACE ON FILE ALL CORRESPONDENCE AND REPORTS. MOTION CARRIED.

HERBERT SIMMONS PRESENTED HIS EMA REPORT OF ACTIVITIES FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY/FEBRUARY 2018. THERE WHERE TWO ADDITIONAL ITEMS SINCE HIS REPORT. THE COMMAND POST WAS DEPLOYED TO BROOKLYN FOR A HOSTAGE SITUATION. WE WHERE CALLED TO RESPOND TO THE HELICOPTER CRASH AT THE AIRPORT IN CAHOKIA.

IT WAS MOVED BY PAUL SEIBERT AND SECONDED BY MICHAEL O'DONNELL TO ACCEPT THE EMA REPORT AND PLACE IT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

TOM KNAPP REPORTED THE IDOC RATE OF CAPACITY FOR THE JAIL WAS 418. OUR AVERAGE JAIL POPULATION FOR DECEMBER WAS 376. INMATES ADMITTED 567, AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY 4 DAYS. OLDEST PERSON WAS 67 YEARS OLD. OUT OF THAT BOOKING, 133 FEMALES, 434 MALES, 217 WERE MISDEMEANORS, 170 FELONS AND 6 FEDERAL. FOR THE YEAR 2017 AVERAGE DALLY POPULATION WAS 395. LAST YEAR OUR AVERAGE WAS 389.

IN 2017 TOTAL ADMISSIONS WAS 7377. THE OLDEST PERSON WAS 83, OF THE 7300, 1897 WAS FEMALES, 5480 MALES, 2908 MISDEMEANORS ARREST, 2088 FELONY ARREST, 97 FEDERALS, 1137 FUGITIVES DOWN FROM 2016.

ON THE PATROL SIDE OF THINGS FOR DECEMBER 258 TRAFFIC STOPS, 144 CITATIONS, 25 MISDEMEANOR ARREST AND 30 WARRANT ARREST.

307 COURTHOUSE CHECKS, 583 PARK PATROLS FOR A TOTAL 6609 POINTS OF CONTACT FOR DECEMBER 2017. YEAR END PATROL ACITIVITY, 4401 TRAFFIC STOPS, 2506 CITATIONS, 183 FELONY ARREST, 401 MISDEMEANOR ARREST.

ENVIORNMENTAL OFFICER FOR DECEMBER MADE 85 ENVIORNMENTAL CONTACTS AND ISSUED 4 CITATIONS. FOR THE YEAR ENVIORNMENTALLY SPEAKING 1285 ENVIORNMENTAL CONTACTS, ISSUED 94 CITATIONS FOR THE YEAR.
