JULY 30, 2018 PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING ROLL CALL.

THERE WERE NO COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC REGARDING THE MEETINGS AGENDA.

IT WAS MOVED BY ROY MOSLEY, JR. AND SECONDED BY PAUL SEIBERT TO APPROVE THE JUNE 2018 MINUTES. MOTION CARRIED.

FRANK BERGMAN READ ALL THE CORRESPONDENCE FOR MONTH. IT WAS MOVED BY STEVE GOMRIC AND SECONDED BY KEVIN DAWSON TO ACCEPT AND PLACE ON FILE ALL CORRESPONDENCE AND THE REPORTS. MOTION CARRIED.

HERBERT SIMMONS READ ALL THE CORRESPONDENCE FOR THE OF JUNE/JULY 2018, E.M.A. REPORT. MR. SIMMONS ALSO THANKED NORMAN ETLING WITH THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT THAT PROVIDED HELP TO THE COMMUNITIES AFTER THE STORM. IT WAS MOVED BY MICHAEL O'DONNELL AND SECONDED BY STEVE GOMRIC TO ACCEPT THE EMA REPORT AND PLACE IT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

TOM KNAPP REPORTED OUR DOC RATE OF CAPACITY WAS 418 AND OUR AVERAGE DAILY POPULATION WAS 323 FOR JUNE, DOWN A LITTLE. THE JAIL BOOKED 588 INMATES, LONGEST LENGTH OF STAY WAS THREE DAYS, AND OLDEST PERSON WAS 67 YEARS OF AGE. OF THE 588 INMATES, 134 WERE FEMALES, 454 MALES OF THOSE 221 WERE MISDEMEANORS 200 FELONS, 6 FEDERALS, AND 74 FUGITIVES.

ON THE PATROL SIDE OF THINGS FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE WE HAD 312 TRAFFIC STOPS, 193 CITATIONS, 38 FELONY ARRESTS, 32 MISDEMEANOR ARRESTS, 41 WARRANT

ARRESTS, 332 COURTHOUSE CHECKS, 555 PARK PATROLS, 2915 BUSINESS/RESIDENTS CHECKS FOR A TOTAL OF 7,910 POINT OF CONTACT WITH GENERAL PUBLIC. REPORTING FOR THE FIRST SIX MONTH, JANUARY THROUGH JUNE OF 2018. WE HAD 2,514 TRAFFIC STOPS, ISSUED 1,480 CITATIONS, 156 FELONY ARRESTS, 189 MISDEMEANORS ARREST, 237 WARRANT ARRESTS, ALSO FOR THE FIRST SIX MONTHS WE DID 1,981 COURTHOUSE CHECKS, 3,537 PARK PATROLS, 18,895 BUSINESS/RESIDENCE CHECKS FOR A TOTAL OF 48,919 POINTS OF CONTACT WITH GENERAL PUBLIC.

THE ENVIRONMENTAL OFFICER HAD 80 CONTACTS, 4 ENVIRONMENTAL CITATIONS ISSUED, 11 VIOLATION NOTICES LEFT AT RESIDENTS. THAT CONCLUDED HIS REPORT. IT WAS MOVED BY ROY MOSLEY, JR. AND SECONDED BY STEVE GOMRICK TO ACCEPT HIS REPORT AND PLACE IT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

FRANK BERGMAN REVIEW OF THE ACCIDENT REPORT STATED ALL ACCIDENT REPORTS ARE IN ORDER AND DEPARTMENT HAVE FILLED OUT THE PROPER PAPERWORK. DOES ANYONE HAVE ANY QUESTIONS? THERE BEING NO QUESTIONS, IT WAS MOVED BY STEVE GOMRICK AND SECONDED BY ROY MOSLEY, JR. TO ACCEPT THE ACCIDENT REPORT AND PLACE ON FILE.
