SIMMONS ALSO THANKED NORMAN ETLING WTH THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT THAT PROVIDED HELP TO THE COMMUNITIES AFTER THE STORM. TOM KNAPP REPORTED OUR DOC RATE OF CAPACITY WAS 418 AND OURAVERAGE DAILY POPULATION WAS 323 FOR JUNE, DOWN A LITTLE. THE JAIL BOOKED 588 INMATES, LONGEST LENGTH OF STAY WAS THREE DAYS, AND OLDEST PERSON WAS 67 YEARS OF AGE. OF THE 588 INMATES, 134WERE FEMALES, 454MALES OF THOSE221WERE MISDEMEANORS 200 FELONS, 6FEDERALS, AND 74FUGITIVES.

ON THE PATROL SIDE OF THINGS FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE WE HAD312 TRAFFIC STOPS,193CITATIONS,38FELONY ARRESTS, 32 MISDEMEANOR ARRESTS, 41WARRANT

ARRESTS, 332COURTHOUSE CHECKS, 555 PARK PATROLS, 2915 BUSINESS/RESIDENTS CHECKS FOR A TOTAL OF 7,910 POINT OF CONTACT WITH GENERAL PUBLIC. REPORTING FOR THE FIRST SIX MONTH, JANUARY THROUGH JUNE OF 2018. WE HAD 2,514 TRAFFIC STOPS, ISSUED 1,480 CITATIONS,156 FELONY ARRESTS, 189 MISDEMEANORS ARREST, 237 WARRANT ARRESTS, ALSO FOR THE FIRST SIX MONTHS WE DID 1,981 COURTHOUSE CHECKS, 3,537 PARK PATROLS, 18,895 BUSINESS/RESIDENCE CHECKS FOR A TOTAL FO 48, 919 POINTS OF CONTACT WITH GENERAL PUBLIC.
