**FRANK BERGMAN READ ALL THE CORRESPONDENCE FOR THE MONTH. IT WAS MOVED BY
ROY MOSLEY, JR. AND SECONDED BY PAUL SEIBERT TO ACCEPT AND PLACE ON FILE ALL
CORRESPONDENCE AND THE REPORTS. MOTION CARRIED.**

**HERBERT SIMMONS READ ALL THE CORRESPONDENCE FOR THE OF APRIL/MAY 2018 E.M.A.
REPORT. IT WAS MOVED BY STEVE GOMRIC AND SECONDED BY MICHAEL O'DONNELL TO
ACCEPT THE EMA REPORT AND PLACE IT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.**

**TOM KNAPP REPORTED OUR DOC RATE OF CAPACITY WAS 418 AND OUR AVERAGE DAILY
POPULATION WAS 318 FOR APRIL. THE JAIL BOOKED 709 INMATES, LONGEST STAY WAS
FOUR DAYS, AND OLDEST PERSON WAS AGE 70. OF THE 709 INMATES, 169 WERE FEMALES, 540
MALES OF THOSE 254 WERE MISDEMEANORS 260 FELONS, 6 FEDERALS, AND 94 FUGITIVES.
ON THE PATROL SIDE OF THINGS FOR THE MONTH APRIL THERE WERE 455 TRAFFIC
STOPS, 242 CITATIONS, 34 FELONY ARREST, 31 MISDEMEANOR ARREST, 45 WARRANT ARREST
AND 357 COURTHOUSE CHECKS, 589 PARK PATROLS WITH A TOTAL OF 8837 POINT OF
CONTACT WITH GENERAL PUBLIC.**

THE ENVIRONMENTAL OFFICER HAD 92 CONTACTS, 10 ENVIRONMENTAL CITATIONS ISSUED, 15 VIOLATION NOTICES LEFT AT RESIDENTS. WE ARE HIRING THREE NEW DEPUTY SHERIFFS' POSITIONS TO WORK THE METRO LINK AND THE TRANSIT DISTRICT IS PAYING FOR THE THREE ADDITIONAL DEPUTIES. IT WAS MOVED BY STEVE GOMRIC AND SECONDED BY KEVIN DAWSON TO ACCEPT HIS REPORT AND PLACE IT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

FRANK BERGMAN REVIEW OF THE ACCIDENT REPORT AND STATED WE HAD TWO ACCIDENTS BUT IT WAS A GOOD MONTH. THERE BEING NO QUESTIONS, IT WAS MOVED BY ROY MOSLEY, JR. AND SECONDED BY STEVE GOMRIC TO ACCEPT THE ACCIDENT REPORT AND PLACE ON FILE.
