**HERBERT SIMMONS READ HIS OCTOBER 2018\NOVEMBER 2018, E.M.A. REPORT TO THE
COMMITTEE. THERE WERE NO QUESTIONS, IT WAS MOVED BY MICHAEL O'DONNELL AND
SECONDED BY STEVE GOMRIC TO ACCEPT THE EMA REPORT AND PLACE IT ON FILE.

**TOM KNAPP REPORTED THAT OUR DOC RATE OF CAPACITY FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER
418. OUR AVERAGE DAILY POPULATION DURING OCTOBER 2018 WAS 374. INMATES
ADMITTED 690, AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY WAS FOUR DAYS, OLDEST PERSON WAS 69 YRS
OF AGE; OF THE 690 INMATES 155 WERE FEMALES AND 535 WERE MALES. BOOKING TYPES,
228 MISDEMEANORS, 257 FELONS, 3 FEDERAL INMATES, AND 98 FUGITIVES WHICH IS PEOPLE
WANTED OUT OF THE COUNTY.**

ON THE PATROL SIDE OF THINGS FOR OCTOBER 2018, WE MADE 344 TRAFFIC STOPS, ISSUED 199 CITATIONS, 25 FELONY ARRESTS, 45 MISDEMEANOR ARRESTS, 28 WARRANT ARRESTS, 370 COURTHOUSE CHECKS, 619 PARK PATROLS AND 3,787 BUSINESS/RESIDENTS CHECKS. TOTAL POINTS OF CONTACT FOR OCTOBER 2018 WAS 8.950 WITH THE GENERAL PUBLIC. THE ENVIRONMENTAL OFFICER HAD 85 CONTACTS MADE, 4 ENVIRONMENTAL CITATIONS ISSUED, 10 VIOLATION NOTICES LEFT AT RESIDENTS. AND FINALLY THE ACCIDENT REVIEW BOARD MEET BUT I DON'T HAVE THEIR REPORT TODAY YET SO I WILL HAVE IT AT THE NEXT MEETING
