THERE WERE NO COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC REGARDING THE MEETINGS AGENDA.

IT WAS MOVED BY PAUL SEIBERT AND SECONDED BY KEVIN DAWSON TO APPROVE THE SEPTEMBER 24, 2018 MINUTES. MOTION CARRIED.

FRANK BERGMAN READ THE DETENTIONS POPULATION REPORT FOR SEPTEMBER 19. THRU OCTOBER 22, 2018. THERE WHERE NO QUESTIONS, IT WAS MOVED BY STEVE GOMRIC AND SECONDED BY PAUL SEIBERT TO ACCEPT AND PLACE ON FILE ALL CORRESPONDENCE AND THE REPORTS. MOTION CARRIED.

HERBERT SIMMONS READ HIS SEPTEMBER\OCTOBER 2018, E.M.A. REPORT TO THE COMMITTEE. THERE WHERE NO QUESTIONS, IT WAS MOVED BY STEVE GOMRIC AND SECONDED BY MICHAEL O'DONNELL TO ACCEPT THE EMA REPORT AND PLACE IT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

TOM KNAPP REPORTED THAT OUR DOC RATE OF CAPACITY WAS 418, WE DID NOT EXCEED THAT. OUR AVERAGE DAILY POPULATION DURING SEPTEMBER 2018 WAS 337. INMATES ADMITTED WAS 5,864 FOR YEAR 2018. LONGEST LENGTH OF STAY WAS 10 DAYS, OLDEST PERSON WAS 80 YEARS OF AGE; OF THE 5,864 INMATES, AND 1,417 WERE FEMALES AND 4,447 MALES. BOOKING TYPES, 2,046 MISDEMEANORS, 1,873 FELONS, 74 FEDERAL INMATES, AND 900 FUGITIVES.

ON THE PATROL SIDE OF THINGS FOR YEAR 2018 WE MADE 3,391 TRAFFIC STOPS, ISSUED 1,975 CITATIONS, 210 FELONY ARRESTS, 285 MISDEMEANOR ARRESTS, 346 WARRANT ARRESTS, 3,025 COURTHOUSE CHECKS, 5,191 PARK PATROLS, 27,500 BUSINESS/RESIDENTS CHECKS.

TOTAL POINTS OF CONTACT FOR NINE MONTHS WAS 72,458. THE ENVIRONMENTAL OFFICER HAD 90 ENVIRONMENTAL CONTACTS MADE, 6 ENVIRONMENTAL CITATIONS ISSUED, 15 VIOLATION NOTICES LEFT AT RESIDENTS.

APPROVAL OF AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SHERIFF TO SIGN A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH SCOTT AIR FORCE BASE WAS APPROVED AND THE SAFETY COMMITTEE MEMBERS SIGNED THE AGREEMENT.

THERE BEING NO QUESTIONS. IT WAS MOVED BY STEVE GOMRIC AND SECONDED BY MIKE O'DONNELL TO ACCEPT HIS REPORT AND SCOTT AIR FORCE AGREEMENT AND PLACE IT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

FRANK BERGMAN STATED REVIEWING ALL THE REPORTS WITH LAURA FREDRICK, THEY APPEAR TO BE IN ORDER FOR SEPTEMBER 2018. THERE BEING NO QUESTIONS, IT WAS MOVED BY MICHAEL O'DONNELL AND SECONDED BY KEVIN DAWSON TO ACCEPT THE ACCIDENT REPORT AND PLACE ON FILE.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, IT WAS MOVED BY STEVE GOMRIC AND SECONDED BY MICHAEL O'DONNELL TO ADJOURN, MOTION CARRIED.
