A RESOLUTION GRANTING A REQUEST FOR A SPECIAL USE PERMIT FOR A PLANNED BUILDING DEVELOPMENT BY MARK KOEHNE - KOEHNE PLUMBING HEATING LLC, OWNERS AND APPLICANTS, FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT 7931 N. ILLINOIS STREET, CASEYVILLE, ILLINOIS, IN CASEYVILLE TOWNSHIP. (CASE #2018-26-SP)

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals, after hearing the testimony and evidence presented, after considering all relevant sections of the St. Clair County Zoning Code, and after further consideration of the matter, granted the applicant's a Special Use Permit for a Planned Building Development pursuant to Section 40-9-3(H) to allow a Plumbing Company in a "SR-3" Single-Family Residence Zone District due to the following: The placement of a plumbing business at this location, subject to any limitations imposed, will not negatively affect the public's health, safety, welfare, and physical environment; the Comprehensive Plan calls for Residential, however, the proposed Special Use will not negatively impact the County's plan as numerous other businesses have been developed in this area, both in the unincorporated area of St. Clair County and the municipal limits of Caseyville; the proposed Special Use will not adversely affect the value of neighboring property, as property in the general vicinity of this parcel is used for both residential and business purposes; the proposed business will not have a negative impact on neighboring property values or the County's overall tax base; there will be no effect on public utilities and minimal effect on traffic circulation because the plumbing business, as described, is not a retail type business with little to no customers appearing at the facility; there are no schools or hospitals in close proximity to the property that would require special consideration; the Board found the Special Use Permit is compatible to adjacent uses in the general vicinity. The Board placed the following conditions and limitations on this Special Use request: No outside storage of any materials, excepting three (3) vehicles and one (1) trailer associated with the business; the Special Use Permit shall be limited to the hours of operation (9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday thru Friday); two employees at the facility; and the Special Use Permit is for the applicant only and does not run with the land.

WHEREAS, the County Board of St. Clair County, Illinois, concur with the aforesaid findings, conditions and recommendations of the Zoning Board of Appeals;
