#### ZONING DIRECTOR'S REPORT - ANNE MARKEZICH

Ms. Markezich stated as she explained at last meeting, the Zoning Department and Health Department no longer have a Sheriff Deputy. Ms. Markezich stated she was told to contact dispatch if the code enforcement officer needs assistance. She will keep the board updated on how this will work out during the upcoming busy season.

Ms. Markezich stated the Zoning office has started doing new construction inspections for the Village of Caseyville. The Village will split the building permit fees with the County.

Mr. Easterley asked if St. Clair County ever considered having the Townships pitch in to help demolish homes in their areas or to support the Clean Sweep Program. (Ms. Markezich stated she will look into his question, but does not think she can force Townships to help pay for demolition costs. She explained she does not feel comfortable obtaining demolition grants, however she would oversee the demolition if the Grants Department obtained the grants, as was done in the past.)

Ms. Markezich stated she is currently looking for a part-time Plumbing Inspector if any of the board members know a retired licensed plumber.
