THERE WERE NO COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC REGARDING THE MEETINGS AGENDA.

IT WAS MOVED BY PAUL SEIBERT AND SECONDED BY STEVE GOMRIC TO APPROVE THE JANUARY 28, 2019 MINUTES. MOTION CARRIED.

FRANK BERGMAN READ THE DETENTIONS POPULATION REPORT FOR JANUARY 11, 2019 THRU FEBRUARY 07, 2019. THERE BEING NO QUESTIONS, IT WAS MOVED BY MICHAEL O'DONNELL AND SECONDED BY KEVIN DAWSON TO ACCEPT AND PLACE ON FILE ALL CORRESPONDENCE AND THE REPORTS. MOTION CARRIED.

HERBERT SIMMONS READ HIS JANUARY 2019/FEBRUARY 2019, E.M.A. REPORT TO THE COMMITTEE.

THERE WHERE NO QUESTIONS, IT WAS MOVED BY STEVEN GOMRIC AND SECONDED BY MICHAEL O'DONNELL TO ACCEPT THE EMA REPORT AND PLACE IT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

TOM KNAPP REPORTED THAT FOR THE MONTHS OF JANUARY 2019 WE AVERAGED 355 AND OUR DOC RATE OF CAPACITY IS 418 THAT IS 70 UNDER. ON THE JAIL SIDE OF THINGS FOR JANUARY WE ADMITTED 685 INMATES, AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY WAS 4 DAYS, OLDEST PERSON 73 YRS OF AGE. OF THE 685 INMATES 182 WERE FEMALES AND 503 MALES, 254 WERE MISDEMEANORS, 225 FELONS, 9 FEDERAL INMATES, AND 91 FUGITIVES AND A HAND FULL OF OTHERS.

ON THE PATROL SIDE OF THINGSFOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY, WE MADE 296 TRAFFIC STOPS, ISSUED 189 CITATIONS, MADE 20 FELONY ARRESTS, 19 MISDEMEANOR ARRESTS, 35 WARRANT ARRESTS, 340 COURTHOUSE SECURITY CHECKS, 617 PARK PATROLS AND 2,090 BUSINESS/RESIDENTS CHECKS. FOR A TOTAL 6,543 POINTS TOTAL OF CONTACT WITH THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

THE ENVIRONMENTAL OFFICER 50 CONTACTS MADE, 3 ENVIRONMENTAL RELATED CITATIONS ISSUED, 8 VIOLATION NOTICES LEFT AT RESIDENTS. FOR THE DEPARTMENT AS A WHOLE 12 ENVIORMENTAL CONTACTS MADE.

PRIOR TO LAST MONTH WE HAD AN OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING AND AT THAT POINT THE OFFICER WAS OFF ON PAID ADMINISTRATIVE LEAVE. HE IS NOW BACK IN SERVICE AFTER HAVING BEEN PSYCHOLGICALLY EVALUATED AND CLEARED, PENDING REVIEW BY THE STATES ATTORNEY OFFICE. THE STATE POLICE HAVE CONCLUED THEIR INVESTIGATION AND MADE CLEAR TO US THAT EVERYTHING WAS A LIE. AT THIS POINT HE IS NOW BACK IN SERVICE.

THERE BEING NO QUESTIONS, IT WAS MOVED BY MICHAEL O'DONNELL AND SECONDED BY PAUL SEIBERT TO ACCEPT HIS REPORT AND PLACE IT ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

FRANK BERGMAN STATED THAT THERE IS NOT MUCH ON THIS MONTHS ACCIDENT REPORT. IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS I'LL BE HAPPY TO ANSWER THEM. THERE BEING NO QUESTIONS, IT WAS MOVED BY STEVE GOMRIC AND SECONDED BY PAUL SEIBERT TO ACCEPT THE ACCIDENT REPORT AND PLACE ON FILE.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, IT WAS MOVED BY MICHAEL O'DONNELL AND SECONDED BY KEVIN DAWSON TO ADJOURN, MOTION CARRIED.
