### A. Director's Report

Rick Stubblefield reminded members LIHEAP is still taking applications every Monday from 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. The program remains busy.

The Community Development Block Grant [CDBG] Annual Action Plan public hearings will be held on March 5<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Stubblefield informed the committee that Matt Jones has accepted the position of Workforce Development Program Coordinator. He added the Workforce Development Group is applying for an additional \$200,000 Youth Apprenticeship Grant; the program recently received a \$400,000 Apprenticeship Grant.

The Housing Resource Center's Point-In-Time count was held January 28th; it was very successful.

The Weatherization program has requested additional funding. Ken Kimball, the Program Coordinator, feels confident the program will receive it. Mr. Stubblefield stated the additional funding will assist the program in completing additional homes this year.
