Trinity Services:

Sarah of Mike Lowry's office at Trinity Services reported on January 16, 2019that the residents are still doing cleanup at Silver Creek Preserve two to three days a week asweather permits. Pizzas were delivered to volunteers on January 4.

> St. Clair County Parks Grant Commission:

The usual completion of projects, requests for extensions and payment of invoices for Cycle 24 have been processed during the last month. All contracts have been returned and processed for Cycle 25.

> 2017 Special Park Projects:

Requests for payments have been processed during the last month on various projects. 2018 Special Park Project contracts are being returned.

➤ Rhutaseland Associates, Inc. submitted an invoice for \$3,625 for professional services. The invoice has been submitted for payment.

A motion was made by Mr. Gomric and seconded by Ms. Moll to approve the reports given by Ms. Meyer. Motion passed unanimously.

Tim Pruett, Rhutasel and Associates, submitted a final invoice from Kruep Construction for \$26,261.35 for the remainder of work completed at Engelmann Farm for the house renovation. The invoice has been submitted for payment. He noted that invoices totaled \$98,435, which was slightly less than the original bid and included extra porch work.

Mr. Pruett advised that he received an estimate from Germantown Seamless Gutters for \$1,701 for replacement of 6" gutters on the house, back porch and garage and installation of gutter guards.

A motion was made by Mr. Gomric and seconded by Mr. Sharkey to approve the work by Germantown Seamless Gutters for \$1,701. Motion passed unanimously.
