# **Director's Report:**

**Items for Information:** 

**Motorola Project Update:** Director Simmons stated that Motorola continues to work towards the movement of equipment to the Emerson Park Metrolink Radio Tower. Staff will meet with a consultant on July 10, 2019 to determine additional aspects of the project.

**Monthly 9-1-1 Call Statistics:** Director Simmons referred to the monthly call statistics for the Board to review.

**PSAP Consolidation Update:** The Director informed the Board that Madison County filed their updated 9-1-1 Consolidation Plan with only corrections to the grammatical errors that were noted in our previous objection. They continued to report the same technical conditions which clearly violate the legislation and also produces challenges related to St. Clair County's handling of 9-1-1 calls as is relates to transfers and proper notification of our emergency responders. After a discussion with the consultant and the ETSB Attorney, an objection to the new plan was drafted and submitted to the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator.

## Audit Trail, Surcharge Report and Fund Summary:

A motion was made by Don Feher and seconded by George Chance to approve the June 2019 Audit Trail and Surcharge Report and the May 2019 Fund Summary. The motion passed unanimously.

**Old Business:** Sheriff Watson led a discussion regarding adding a tower in the Fayetteville area.

**New Business:** St. Clair County Board Member Ed Cockrell asked for clarification on dispatching fees for private ambulance companies.
