Motorola Project Update: Director Simmons informed the Board that Motorola is moving forward with relocating the equipment for installation at the Emerson Park Tower, which will replace the existing tower at Norfolk Southern.

Monthly 9-1-1 Call Statistics: Director Simmons referred to the monthly call statistics for the Board to review.

PSAP Consolidation Update: Director Simmons reported that the May meeting of the Statewide 9-1-1 Advisory Board was cancelled.
