A. Chairman Reeb asked about the upcoming customer assistance event. Rick Stubblefield responded the event is taking place on the 19th at the Jackie Joyner-Kersee Center in East St. Louis. He explained IGD will be partnering with Ameren to offer energy assistance to individuals; the \$150 assistance is in addition to LIHEAP assistance. IGD LIHEAP staff will assist with the applications. Mr. Dancy asked for a flyer. Mr. Stubblefield responded he will provide him with flyers following the meeting.

B. Director's Report

Rick Stubblefield informed members Latosha Johnson, Housing Resource Center Coordinator, has been named to the St. Louis Area Regional Commission on Homeless. The commission will primarily focus on homeless veterans.

The Community Development Group recently held five public hearings to discuss the Annual Action Plan. The hearings went well.

Mr. Stubblefield attended the Association of Defense Communities Installation last week. He expressed Scott AFB is a big part of the area's economy. IGD Workforce Development Group is very involved with Scott AFB; the group briefs everyone transitioning out of the military there. Mr. Stubblefield stated he gained a great connection with Colorado and their work with military spouses. He gained ideas that we will implement here.

Weatherization has received an additional \$310,000 in funding. Ken Kimball, Weatherization Coordinator, is deciding how those funds will be spent. Chairman Reeb asked if the additional funds were unexpected. Mr. Stubblefield responded additional funds are common each year; however, not that amount. He added the Community Service Group may receive additional funding as well. Chairman Reeb asked if the additional funds are federal or state. Mr. Stubblefield responded state.
