Page 2 – St. Clair County Animal Services (January 25th 2021)

Cheri report:

Month of December our save rate was 97%. For the year 2020, we were at 98% average. In 2020 we brought in 1628 animals into our facility. We euthanized 93 for the public at the owner's request.

Mr. Trentman: That's probably one of the best years ever, would you agree?

Cheri: Yes, it is. We're working really hard to try to keep it that way.

Mr. Trentman: How are the kennels looking? Full?

Cheri: We're about half way.

Mr. Trentman: Do you have a lot of calls lately?

Cheri: When it got cold, we were getting a lot of humane care complaints. Today I was expecting a lot of calls coming in because its cold and rainy, but we really didn't have more than a few calls today. Probably Wednesday if it snows, we'll get humane care complaints.

Mr. Trentman: Were you able to get with Harry with the problem in Washington Park?

Cheri: No, he did not contact me.

Mr. Hollingsworth: I called, but in some kind of way, I got turned around with the call. Hopefully, if it's possible sometime this week if the weather permits, we can sit down and talk about what I need.

Cheri: That will be fine.

Mr. Trentman: How are adoptions going?

Cheri: Last Friday, we had three dogs go home. We have a pending application on another one that just came available today. They're going steady. When Covid first started, they were flying out the doors. Now they're sort of back to a regular pace.

Mr. Trentman: Sounds like things are good.

Mr. Wilhelm: I just have some questions about some of the abbreviations because I'm new to this. It doesn't have to be during this meeting.
