Cheri report:

For the month of February our save rate was 100%. We had 9 animals adopted in February. This month we had the opportunity to do a COVID-19 emergency food distribution. We worked with Dr. Sandy Gilmore. She is the emergency program coordinator with the Illinois Department of Agriculture and also Kathy Wiesner who is with Rescue Pack of Chicago. We had a truck come in with 30,000 pounds of dog and cat food and litter that we distributed to Calhoun, Green, Madison and St. Clair County. I want to thank Mike Suarez at the highway department. They had a great building that we were able to unload the food into and a forklift operator to assist the people coming to pick up the food. I was told that the food is actually being donated by three anonymous people. They are paying for all the food and sending semis all throughout the state of Illinois to help families in need.

Mr. Trentman: How did we disperse the food from the warehouse? Did they come get it?

Cheri: Everybody who participated came and either brought a trailer or trucks. The forklift operator helped them load it. Some people were just bringing pickup trucks.

Mr. Hollingsworth: Question: Is all the food gone? Did you all get rid of all of it?

Cheri: Yes, I was gone in the same day. Illinois Department of Agriculture sent out invite letters. The groups had to be in Illinois, either a government agency or a licensed rescue. So the people who needed the food, RSVP'd. I was then in contact with them when the truck came. I wasn't sure how much we were getting. Originally we were supposed to get 46,000 pounds but then the big storm came in and it was delayed. There was a truck that was meant to go to a different county, but they couldn't take it so we took it. I didn't know how much was going to be on it until it arrived. Once it did, everyone who RSVP'd got something.

Mr. Hollingsworth: Next time, let me know about it. I would like to put the East Saint Louis Township as a government agency. We give food out to needy people. Whoever comes in that needs it. If something comes up again, is it possible to let me or the township know?

Cheri: That's not a problem.
