CONTRACT FOR SERVICES

STANLEY J. NIEMANN, DVM, ADMINISTRATOR / ANIMAL CONTROL, 850 South State Street, Freeburg, Illinois 62243, and the ST. CLAIR COUNTY BOARD, hereby enter into a CONTRACT FOR SERVICES under the terms and conditions described below:

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- 1.) The contract shall begin on January 01, 2022 and terminate on December 31, 2022.
- 2.) The Contract may be renewed on an annual basis with the written consent of both parties, notice of intent by both parties to be provided prior to the 1st of December each year.
- 3.) The Contract may be terminated by either party, with or without cause, upon provision of sixty (60) days written notice.
- 4.) The Administrator will be an independent contractor and not an employee of ST. CLAIR COUNTY for any purpose whatever.
- 5.) The terms and conditions contained in this document constitute the entire agreement of the parties and may only be supplemented, deleted, or altered by mutually agreed modification.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES, DUTIES, AND POWERS OF ANIMAL CONTROL

ADMINISTRATOR:

- 1.) The Administrator will be a currently licensed veterinarian in the State of Illinois.
- 2.) The Administrator shall perform all statutory duties enumerated in 510 ILCS 5/5.
- 3.) The Administrator shall have all police power as defined in 510 ILCS 5/5.
- 4.) The Administrator shall provide emergency treatment services as defined by standard veterinary practice for all animals received in the Animal Services Department during normal office operating hours.
- 5.) The Administrator will prepare laboratory specimens for shipment as needed.
- 6.) The Administrator will vaccinate all quarantined animals for the sum of \$17.00 per animal.
- 7.) The Administrator will provide pre-release examinations for all quarantined animals for the sum of \$17.00 per animal.
- 8.) The Administrator shall provide spay/neuter surgeries for the Pet Population Clinic animals at a fee of \$55.00 per animal.

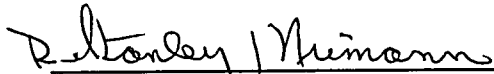
- 9.) The Administrator shall provide spay/neuter surgeries for the Adoption Center animals at a cost not to exceed \$75.00 per animal unless pre-approved by the Director.
- 10.) The Administrator will respond to all public inquiries regarding the care of quarantined animals.
- 11.) The Administrator will provide liability insurance for any and all activities undertaken on behalf of ST. CLAIR COUNTY naming ST. CLAIR COUNTY as a named insured.
- 12.) The Administrator will provide such written or oral reports as may be required by the ST. CLAIR COUNTY BOARD and /or the State of Illinois.

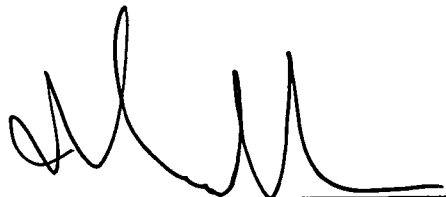
III. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF ST. CLAIR COUNTY:

- 1.) ST. CLAIR COUNTY will pay ADMINISTRATOR the sum of TWENTY THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$20,400.00) per annum, in the equal monthly installments of ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$1,700.00) payable to Freeburg Animal Hospital, said remuneration to be payment in full for all services and expenses except as noted in Section II (6) and (7) of this Contract.

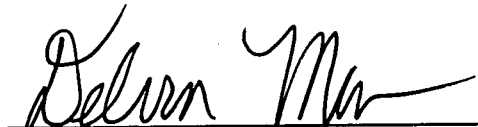
- 2.) ST. CLAIR COUNTY will make available work areas and equipment necessary for the ADMINISTRATOR to complete his/her assigned responsibilities.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED CODE OF ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS, GRANTING A REZONING FOR PROPERTY, OWNED BY CSQ HOLDINGS LLC, CASPER QUARRY & CONT CO, & MCLEAN STONE COMPANY, AND APPLIED FOR BY KIENSTRA ST.CLAIR, LLC, ON PROPERTY KNOWN AS 2615 STOLLE RD, XXXX STOLLE RD & XXXX JESSE AV, DUPO, ILLINOIS, IN CENTREVILLE TOWNSHIP. (2021-04-ZA)

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held in the County Board Room, 5th Floor, St. Clair County Building, #10 Public Square, Belleville, Illinois, on November 2, 2021 at 6:45 P.M., before the Zoning Board of Appeals and notice of said hearing was duly given; and,

WHEREAS, a petition was presented requesting the granting of a Zoning Amendment to change the zone district classification of certain tracts of land from "A" Agricultural Industry Zone District to "I-2" General Industrial Zone District, on the hereinafter described property: Parcel 06-11.0-303-003 - Pt of the SW 1/4 of Section 11 containing 3.41-acres more or less; Parcel 06-14.0-100-009 - Pt of the NW 1/4 of Section 14 containing 4.96-acres more or less; and Parcel 06-10.0-401-004 - Pt of the abandoned railroad ROW in Section 10 containing 1.7-acres more or less; all parcels located in T. 1 N., R. 10 W., of the 3rd PM, in St. Clair County,

Illinois containing 10-acres, which is known as 2615 Stolle Rd, XXXX Stolle Rd & XXXX Jesse Av, Dupo, Illinois, in Centreville Township; and,

WHEREAS, on November 2, 2021, the Zoning Board of Appeals after considering evidence and testimony presented at this hearing; after considering all relevant sections of the St. Clair County Zoning Code; and after further consideration of this matter granted the applicants Zoning Amendment (2021-04-ZA) based upon the following findings and subject to the following stipulations:

- (1) Given the existing industrial type uses of neighboring properties, proximity to I-255 and an active quarry, the proposed rezoning to I-2 is in harmony with the current neighboring uses.
- (2) There is a mixed use of agricultural, business, and heavy commercial uses in the general vicinity, and there are no nearby residential developments.
- (3) While the subject parcels could be used for agricultural purposes, such would require significant clearing. However, given the subject parcels proximity to other commercial uses and I-255 such support an industrial type use.
- (4) The subject properties are suitable to be used for industrial (I-2) type uses.
- (5) There is no current trend of residential or other light business development in this immediate area, but various heavier commercial uses (crane company/yard; gas pipeline facility, and active quarry) have been in existence since the subject properties were initially zoned and such have remained in operation and have expanded over the years, thus, demonstrating the need for further expansion of similar or complementary zoning classifications.
- (6) While the proposed rezoning is not in harmony with the County's Comprehensive Plan, such rezoning will have minimal effect on the County's Comprehensive Plan of "agricultural", given the limited use of the subject parcels for agricultural purposes.

WHEREAS, the County Board of St. Clair County, Illinois, concur in the aforesaid findings and recommendations of the Zoning Board of Appeals;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the County Board of St. Clair County, Illinois, that the request for a Zoning Amendment be granted.

Attorney Brian Flynn presented the case for the Applicant. Mr. Flynn described the parcels in question and current land uses—overgrown with weeds, trees, and brush, and one parcel containing a small amount of farm ground. He further stated that the property abuts I-255 to the east, to the west it abuts a crane company/storage yard (zoned B-2), and further west is a gas pipeline facility. He also stated across the road to the north are derelict properties that contain abandoned structures and trash and debris. One of the subject parcels is an old railroad right-of-way, however, the Applicant is only purchasing and requesting rezoning of only 1.7 acres of that parcel. The remainder of that parcel will remain zoned "A". Thus, the total acreage to be rezoned is approximately 10.07 acres.

Scott Mayberry, representative of Kienstra St. Clair LLC, testified that Kienstra plans to purchase the property if zoning is approved and construct a ready-mix plant on site. He stated there is a need in the area for a ready-mix plant and they anticipate future development in the area that will expand that need. He stated that 15 jobs will be created from this development. Mr. Mayberry reviewed pictures of properties in the general vicinity.

Anne Cramer, representative of the owner, testified that she did her due diligence on the Applicant, and she believes the Applicant will be a good neighbor and that the Applicant runs and keeps nice facilities.

County Board Member David Langford testified in support of the application.

There were no other persons present that testified for or against the request.

Witnesses having been sworn, testimony and evidence presented, and the Zoning Board of Appeals being fully advised in the premises, and the Board having considered the following in conjunction therewith, and found:

- (1) Given the existing industrial type uses of neighboring properties, proximity to I-255 and an active quarry, the proposed rezoning to I-2 is in harmony with the current neighboring uses.
- (2) There is a mixed use of agricultural, business, and heavy commercial uses in the general vicinity, and there are no nearby residential developments.
- (3) While the subject parcels could be used for agricultural purposes, such would require significant clearing. However, given the subject parcels proximity to other commercial uses and I-255 such support an industrial type use.

- (4) The subject properties are suitable to be used for industrial (I-2) type uses.
- (5) There is no current trend of residential or other light business development in this immediate area, but various heavier commercial uses (crane company/yard; gas pipeline facility, and active quarry) have been in existence since the subject properties were initially zoned and such have remained in operation and have expanded over the years, thus, demonstrating the need for further expansion of similar or complementary zoning classifications.
- (6) While the proposed rezoning is not in harmony with the County's Comprehensive Plan, such rezoning will have minimal effect on the County's Comprehensive Plan of "agricultural", given the limited use of the subject parcels for agricultural purposes.

Based upon the above testimony and facts, the Zoning Board of Appeals recommends approval of this request.

A motion was made by G. Meister to **GRANT** the request. The motion was seconded by S. Howell. The members of the Board voted as follows: S. Penny-Yes, M. Deitz-Yes, G. Meister-Yes, S. Howell-Yes, S. Lindauer-Yes, and A. Edwards-Yes. The motion carried 6 to 0.

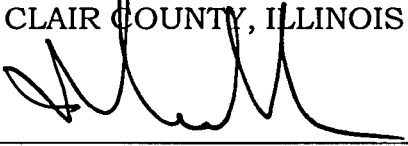

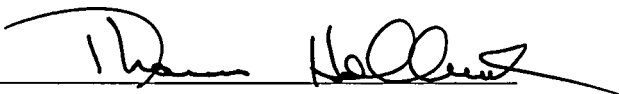

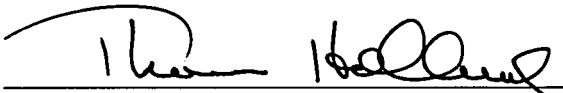

Applicant SMR LLC through Rich Gorazd present the application. Mr. Gorazd testified that he is a home builder and his company SMR LLC (a/k/a State Construction) builds quality homes in the O'Fallon, Illinois area. He stated that there is a demand for quality homes on larger tracts of land (5+ acres). He is desiring to purchase 31.92 acres from Pausch Properties LLC to develop six lots containing at least 5-acres each. Each would have a separate driveway, public water, and public sewers are too far and thus, septic or aeration would be utilized. The houses would be a minimum of 2,000 sq. ft., 2 car garage, with a minimum brick requirement, with 50 ft. set back all sides, and only one outbuilding or pool house would be allowed. He also will have restrictive covenants on the 6 lots, and if approved, he agreed to make a modification to the last covenant requiring that all governmental agencies rules and regulations must be complied with.

Applicant acknowledged that if approved, since all lots are greater than 5 acres a subdivision plat would be required and each lot will have its own PSDS.

Representative for the property owner, Craig Kombrink, indicated the lot to the north of Pausch Road by itself (9.75 acres) would be retained by the owners for a possible residential structure and thus, requested if approved that one residential structure be able to be constructed thereon. 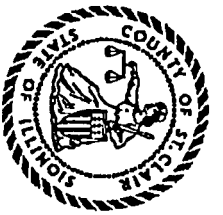

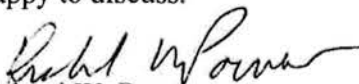
On behalf of St. Clair County, Hays Companies completed our evaluation of the proposed medical, dental and vision renewals and the annual marketing of the stop loss contract for the medical plan. Our recommendations are as follows:

Medical and Vision – UMR is our current vendor and has proposed a modest 2.8% increase in administrative fees for 2022. There will be no rate increase in 2023 as this same rate will apply. This is a very competitive rate and the County has enjoyed many years of service with UMR and their pharmacy partner – OptumRx. We recommend that the County accept the UMR proposal for plan year 2022.

Dental – Delta Dental of Illinois is our current vendor and has proposed a 3.0% increase in administrative fees for 2022. As was the case with UMR, the requested Delta Dental increase is in line with trends that we are seeing in dental renewals. We also recommend that the County accept the Delta Dental renewal proposal for plan year 2022.

Stop Loss - As you may remember in January 2020 we switched to Berkley as our Stop Loss carrier which resulted in **reduction** of approximately \$35,000 from the County's 2019 rates. We renewed our 2021 Stop loss contract with Berkley with a nominal 0.5% increase. The Berkley 2022 stop loss renewal proposed an increase of 7.5% or approximate \$50,000. It is our custom to market stop loss on an annual basis as this is a very fluid market. Our marketing efforts resulted in a proposal from HCC with a **reduction** of approximately \$11,000 from the County's 2021 rates. We recommend the County select this option which mirrors the current plan.

SUBJECT: December 1, 2021 Property, Casualty, and Cyber Liability & Network Security Renewal Summary

We are pleased to present the December 1, 2021 Property and Casualty Renewal Summary to St. Clair County, IL, St. Clair County 911, the Intergovernmental Grants Department, and MidAmerica St. Louis Airport (collectively "SCC/MAA"). Over the last two renewal cycles, we have aligned all but one of the renewal dates to December 1, and we have consolidated all available coverages excluding the MAA property coverage which remains as a separate policy. The MAA Airport Owners & Operators Liability coverage remains an April 1 effective date as this was advantageous due to a multi-year rate agreement.

Overall Results Of December 1, 2021 Renewal

The total renewal pricing is **\$2,134,680**; noting that the results represent an annual increase of **\$179,617 or 9.2%**.

Please note the following:

- Absent the Cyber Liability and Network Security ("Cyber") renewal, the Property and Casualty renewal significantly beats the overall market and represents an annual decrease of **(\$11,807) or (0.6%)**.
- The Cyber renewal is driving the overall increase and as of this writing, is an estimated expense that will be "no worse than" what is included in the table below
 - The primary \$5,000,000 of coverage is complete; we are still finalizing the excess \$5,000,000 of coverage and we are working to secure an additional option (if possible)
 - To date, we have approached over 30 markets and the London market to secure the renewal terms
 - We continue to work the renewal to improve pricing and to improve the deductible (if possible)

Current Market Conditions

Over the past 36 months, the insurance marketplace has been tumultuous at best. Clients and insurers have confronted a pandemic, economic downturn, a hard market, civil commotion, increased natural catastrophes and a sudden shift to remote work. During this time, insurance rates have risen to historic highs with many insured's experiencing 100%+ increases in pricing. Although the insurance market has become more predictable today than it was 36 months ago, the market continues to produce double digit premium increases. Property, umbrella / excess, and cyber remain extremely volatile.

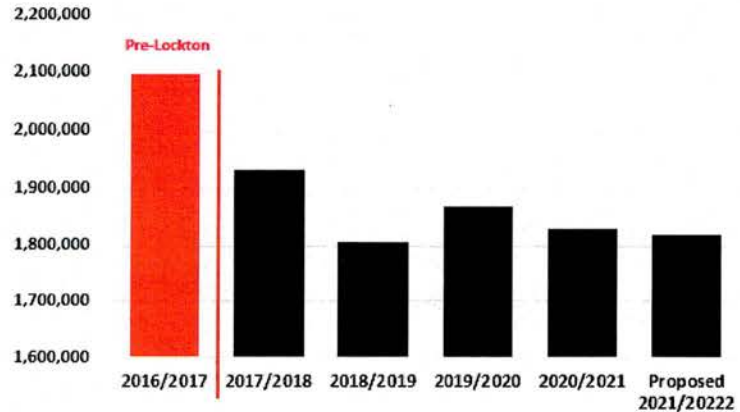
The Cyber in particular market has been "hardening" at a rapid pace driven by primarily due to the rise of ransomware attacks throughout all industries and the resulting losses from those attacks. The highly publicized hacks of managed service providers and critical infrastructure organizations has significantly accelerated an already firming market. The concern has resulted in top cyber carriers taking dramatic actions which has

spread throughout the rest of the cybermarketplace. We've seen carriers deploy much more drastic measures due to the uncertainty of potential claims activity which may arise.

SCC/MAA's Historical Results

Excluding the Cyber coverage, which was a new coverage for SCC/MAA in the 2019/2020 renewal, SCC/MAA have not experienced the same market dynamics as the balance of the market; in fact, quite the opposite.

With this being the third renewal in these unprecedented market conditions, SCC/MAA have enjoyed decreases or low single digit increases for each of the last three renewals. These results handily beat the market overall. Considering the year over year compounding nature of these increases, one could opine that SCC/MAA has experienced over \$1,200,000 in economic benefit over this period. Additionally, SCC/MAA is in the enviable position of paying less for the 2021/22 property and casualty renewal than it did for the 2016/17 renewal.

#2668-21-R

WHEREAS, the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor was created to provide services to State's Attorneys in Counties containing less than 3,000,000 inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, the powers and duties of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor are defined and enumerated in the "State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor's Act", 725 ILCS 210/1 et seq., as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly appropriates monies for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, one-third from the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor's County Fund and two-thirds from the General Revenue Fund, provided that such funding receives approval and support from the respective Counties eligible to apply; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor shall administer the operation of the appellate offices so as to insure that all participating State's Attorneys continue to have final authority in preparation, filing, and arguing of all appellate briefs and any trial assistance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the St. Clair County Board, in regular session, this 29th day of November 2021, does hereby support the continued operation of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, and designates the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor as its Agent to administer the operation of the appellate offices and process said appellate court cases for this County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attorneys employed by the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor are hereby authorized to act as Assistant State's Attorneys on behalf of the State's Attorney of this County in the appeal of all cases when requested to do so by the State's Attorney, and with the advice and consent of the State's Attorney, prepare, file, and argue appellate briefs for those cases; and also, as may be requested by the State's Attorney, to assist in the prosecution of cases under the Illinois Controlled Substances Act, the Cannabis Control Act, the Drug Asset Forfeiture Procedure Act, and the Narcotics Profit Forfeiture Act. Such attorneys are further authorized to assist the State's Attorney in the trial and appeal of tax objections.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor will offer Continuing Legal Education training programs to the State's Attorneys and Assistant State's Attorneys.

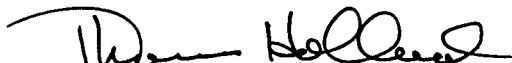
