ST. CLAIR COUNTY SHERIFF DEPARTMENT

Report for the month of November 1, 2021, ending November 30, 2021, included the following data: Average Daily Population was 494, inmates admitted 426 of those 108 were females, 318 males, 134 misdemeanors, 193 felons, 7 federal, 69 fugitives, Sentence Weekend Bookings 3, Sentence County Bookings 3, D.O.C 13 and Other 4. On the patrol side for the month of November 2021 there were 162 traffic citations, 116 traffic warnings, 87 felony/misdemeanors, 39 warrant arrests, 360 park patrol, 1249 business checks and 173 courthouse check for a total of 999 points of contact with the public.
