- ➤ Trinity Services: Sarah at Trinity Services reported on October 18, 2021 that the residents have resumed cleanup at Silver Creek preserve 2 to 3 days a

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week as weather permits. Pizzas were sent to the volunteers on October 1, 2021.

- > St. Clair County Parks Grant Commission: Contracts for Cycle 27 are currently being returned.
- > 2019 Special Park Projects: Requests for payments have been processed during the last month on various projects.
- > Volkert Engineering: Volkert Engineering submitted an invoice for \$6,000 for contractual services. The invoice has been submitted for payment.

Mr. Pruett reported that Volkert was working with DMS to get oil and chip work done at Foley Park.

Motion was made by Mr. Gomric and seconded by Mr. Tieman to approve the Committee reports given by Ms. Meyer and Mr. Pruett. Motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Kern reported on special projects and requested an additional meeting be held to approve special grants.
