Cheri Report:

For the month of March, the save rate was at 99%. Last month, the adoption center did 19 adoptions, which is really good. They're going to have a pretty good month in April too. Our kennels are full. We have two dog kennels open on the animal control side. It's just getting to be that time of year. We're taking the calls as we get them and we have space. As far as owner surrendered animals go, we have started a waiting list. People who want to surrender their animals and we're taking their information and talking them through keeping them when possible, referring them for resources. Otherwise we'll put them on the list. We probably have about 25 on the list now. We're triaging which ones can wait a little bit and which ones need to come in now. It seems to be working our pretty good. The majority of people understand and are willing to give us the information and talk to us.

Mr. O'Donnell: So you don't have to euthanize them.

Cheri: No, we wouldn't. If we don't have the space we can't take the animal from them.

Mr. Trentman: I talked to Shelly Korves from BAHS. She say they're full down the street.

Cheri: Everyone is full. GPG and BAHS are full.

Mr. Trentman: What do you think the ratio is of pitbulls? They're kind of hard to find homes for. Half at least?

Cheri: More than half, probably closer to 90%.

Mr. Trenman: That is tough.
