- > 2019 Special Park Projects: Requests for payments have been processed during the last month on various projects.
- > 2021 Special Park Projects: Requests for payments have been processed during the last month on various projects.
- > Volkert Engineering: Volkert Engineering submitted an invoice for \$6,000 for contractual services. The invoice was paid on June 15.
