Request: A Special Use Permit to allow a business establishment licensed to sell liquor and/or alcoholic beverages by the drink in a B-2 zoning district, upon property commonly known as 821 S. Belt West, Belleville, St. Clair Township, Illinois (PPN: 08-28.0-146-003).

Applicant's Attorney Brian Flynn presented the application. Appearing with Mr. Flynn was a member of 821 Belleville, LLC, Jeff Rehberger. Mr. Rehberger's son's company MRE Portfolio One LLC is the owner of the property in question. Mr. Flynn stated that this property is a strip center with other business ventures currently operating, including a currently operating gaming parlor. Mr. Flynn stated that the Applicant is applying for the SUP to sell liquor and/or alcoholic beverages by the drink in order to open a second gaming parlor in the strip center. The Applicant plans to rent a 900 sq. ft. unit at 821 S. Belt West. The Applicant will operate a gaming parlor with 6 gaming terminals, hours of operation--9:00 a.m., 7 days a week, but hours will be dictated by the liquor license. The Applicant will employ 6-7 employees covering 21 weekly shifts. While there is no per se drink limit all employees will have Illinois training and will watch for overserved patrons. As for alcohol the Applicant will only serve can beer and wine, no hard liquor. While Applicant does not have any locations currently in St. Clair County, Illinois he has other gaming parlor locations in the Highland area. The building has approximately 50 parking spaces available, but such are shared with other businesses.

John Coers, Risk Management (Facilities & Insurance) for the Diocese of Belleville, appeared and spoke against the Application on behalf of the Diocese of Belleville. Mr. Coers stated that the Bishop's residence adjoins the strip center and the proposal would generate noise and because of the late hours would lead to disruptions in the area. Mr. Coers was asked why the Diocese did not object to the prior application for a similar request in 2018, which Mr. Coers responded that he was not aware of the previous application and he has just recently taken this current position with the Diocese.

It was discussed by the Zoning Board and the Applicant that the likely source of any noise was the neighboring large gas station (across Centreville Ave.) that operates 24/7. Zoning Administrative Staff noted that the Zoning Department has not received any complaints with the currently operating gaming parlor located in the strip center in question.

Witnesses having been sworn, testimony and evidence presented, and the Zoning Board of Appeals being fully advised in the premises, and the Board having considered the following in conjunction therewith, and found:

- (1) Whether the proposed design, location, development and operation of the proposed Special Use will adequately protect the public health, safety, and welfare and the physical environment. The Board found as follows: The allowing of liquor and/or alcohol to be sold and served by the drink in conjunction with the placement of a video gaming parlor into an existing strip center, which is underutilized, will not negatively affect the public's health, safety, and welfare.
- (2) Whether the proposed Special Use is consistent with the County's comprehensive plan. The Board found as follows: There are no facilities such as schools or hospitals in close proximity to the proposed Special Use that require special consideration. However, a representative of the Diocese of Belleville objected to the application because the Bishop's residence abuts the strip center to the north-east and the proposal will allegedly generate noise. The Diocese has not complained of noise from any of the existing tenants of the strip center, which includes a currently operating video gaming parlor. Further, it was discussed that any noise generated was likely coming from the nearby large 24/7 gas station/convenient store.
- (6) Whether the proposed Special Use is compatible to adjacent uses and uses in the general vicinity. The Board found as follows: The Special Use is compatible to adjacent uses and uses in the general vicinity.
- (7) The time period for which the Special Use Permit should be granted or any special requirements for certification of continued compliance with the terms of approval. The Board found as follows: The special use permit is to this Applicant only, and so long as the Applicant operates the facility as a video gaming parlor.

A motion was made by A. Edwards to *GRANT* the request with the aforementioned conditions, the motion was seconded by M. Deitz. The members of the Board voted as follows: S. Penny-Yes, M. Deitz-Yes, G. Meister-Yes, A. Edwards-Yes, and S. Lindauer-Yes. The motion carried 5 to 0.

IT IS THEREFORE THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE ST. CLAIR COUNTY ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS THAT THE REQUESTED SPECIAL USE PERMIT BE *GRANTED* FOR THE AFOREMENTIONED REASONS BY A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS PRESENT, WITH THE CONDITIONS THAT THE SPECIAL USE PERMIT IS TO THIS APPLICANT ONLY, AND SO LONG AS THE APPLICANT OPERATES THE FACILITY AS A VIDEO GAMING PARLOR.

We are pleased to present the April 1, 2022 Airport Owners and Operators Liability ("Airport Liability") renewal to St. Clair County, IL, St. Clair County 911, the Intergovernmental Grants Department, and MidAmerica St. Louis Airport (collectively "SCC/MAA").

Results Of April 1, 2022 to April 1, 2024 Renewal

The total annual renewal pricing is \$37,418; noting that the result represents an annual increase of \$5,336 or 16.6%. Given the continued growth as respects to Enplaned Passengers and Total Aircraft Operations, we recommend remaining on a two-year term in order to lock in the existing rates. A few comments/observations are noted below:

- The pricing increase is primarily driven by the following:
 - Current market conditions (insurance and re-insurance)
 - 5.6% increase in Enplaned Passengers
 - 14.3% increase in Total Aircraft Operations (take-offs and landings)
- Recommended two-year term
 - The Airport Liability policy is coming off of a two-year term from April 1, 2020 to April 1, 2022
 - This policy is the only remaining renewal that has not yet been consolidated with the December 1
 effective date for the balance of SCC/MAA's property and casualty program
 - To date, it has been advantageous to SCC/MAA to absorb current market pricing increases by locking in a two-year term
 - In order to align the effective dates, we looked at a short-term policy from April 1, 2022 to December 1, 2022 and we looked at an April 1, 2022 to December 1, 2023 term
 - In working with the markets, they committed to doing either of these options with an additional 7.5% rate increase at either December 1, 2022 or 2023.
 - Given the anticipated continued increases in Enplaned Passengers and Total Aircraft Operations, we believe it continues to be in SCC/MAA's best interest to remain on a two-year term
- Key limits, sub-limits, and deductibles remain as expiring
 - There is not enough premium to support increasing the current deductibles
 - Key limits, sublimits, and the deductible is summarized on the following page

St. Clair County Board Chairman Mark A. Kern, with support of the County Board, implemented the Clean Sweep Program in 2006. The program was initially developed to clear Trustee properties that had become dump sites and to assist non-profit church and community groups. Over time, it expanded to offer support to communities, organized neighborhood cleanups and county residents to aid in the disposal of unwanted household items. The program is staffed by 2 part-time employees and a supervisor. Clean-Sweep disposes of approximately ten to fifteen thousand tons of waste annually.

The vehicles used to offer these services include: one Sterling rear loading refuse truck with 215,788 miles and 219,573 hours; one 2012 International dump truck with approximately 15,000 miles; one 2011 F450 dump truck with approximately 59,000 miles; and one 2008 F250 pick-up truck with approximately 120,000 miles. The need for replacement of the refuse truck is evident. Working with the county garage supervisor George Markezich, to identify a possible replacement vehicle, resulted in direct contacts as listed below, and the purchase recommendation as stated.


