- > Silver Creek Preserve: Kevin Porter reported on October 17, 2022 that there are currently no problems.
- ➤ Trinity Services: Sarah at Trinity Services reported on October 17, 2022 that the residents are cleaning up at Silver Creek Preserve 2 to 3 days a week as weather permits. Pizzas for cleanup volunteers were delivered on October 7, 2022.
- > St. Clair County Parks Grant Commission: Cycle 27 requests for payment have been processed during the last month on various projects. Cycle 28 grant contracts were mailed out and have a deadline for completion of the project of September 1, 2023.
- > 2019 Special Park Projects: Requests for payments have been processed during the last month on various projects.
- > 2021 Special Park Projects: Requests for payments have been processed during the last month on various projects.

Brian Buehlhorn reported to the committee that they would be using the 2021 Special Park Grant for brush cutting at Silver Creek. Which would cost \$13,000, we would be able to do another round of brush cutting since the award was for \$50,000. Brian mentioned that the Mowers yearly maintenance was needed.
