- 8. Attended the Statewide 9-1-1 Next Generation 9-1-1 planning meeting.

- 11. Motorola and the siren vendor are working on installing an new Repeater/Transmitter at the Jail this week which is expected to accommodate both the existing system and the new system while transitions are made. Once that is completed installations of additional sirens will continue.
- 12. Working with IEMA regarding the flood buyouts. The vendor is currently ranking the properties based on criteria established by IEMA and FEMA. Once all properties are ranked, the next step is hiring the appraisal firm to begin appraising properties in rank order.

ST. CLAIR COUNTY SHERIFF DEPARTMENT

Colonel Thomas Knapp reported the following for the month of August 1, 2023, ending August 31, 2023, which included the following data: Average Daily Population was 495, inmates admitted 560 of those 152 were females, 408 males, 146 misdemeanors, 287 felons, 11 federal, 85 fugitives, Sentence Weekend Bookings 6, Sentence County Bookings 5, D.O.C 17 and Other 3. There were 193 traffic citations, 111 traffic warnings, 90 felony/misdemeanors, warrant arrests, 360 park patrol, 1060 business checks and 69 courthouse checks, for a total of 877 points of contact with the general public.
