Upon a motion by Mr. Gomric and seconded by Mr. Vernier, it was unanimously agreed to approve Transportation Res. #2886-23-RT – Authorizing an Agreement Between St. Clair County and the City of Fairview Heights for the Improvements to the Intersection of Old Collinsville Road and Ashland Avenue.

Upon a motion by Ms. Gruberman and seconded by Mr. Vernier, it was unanimously agreed to approve Transportation Res. #2887-23-RT – Authorizing \$385,000 from County Motor Fuel Tax Fund and \$20,000 from County Highway Fund for the Improvements of Baldwin Rod from Approximately 550 Feet North of Golden Rule Mine Road to 750 Feet North of Golden Rule Mine Road.
