Public Comments:

Attorney Report: Attorney Dave Schneidewind informed the ETSB Board that he has been working through numerous FOIA requests this month. He also provided an update on Madison County litigation matters. No action needs to be taken by the ETSB Board at this time.

Monthly Call Statistics: Director Herb Simmons referred to the call statistics for the ETSB Board to review.

Statewide 9-1-1 Advisory Board: Director Simmons informed the ETSB Board that the July 2024 meeting of the Statewide 9-1-1 Advisory Board was cancelled.

ETSB staff is participating and submitting comments in the joint IL APCO / IL NENA review of the recently released draft administrative rule. The state is attempting to make multiple operational level changes that are being objected to by agencies throughout the state.

NG 9-1-1 Grant: Director Simmons updated the ETSB Board on the NG 9-1-1 expenses grant that ETSB staff applied for earlier this year to offset the \$1,300,000.00 downpayment for the NG 9-1-1 system that was recently installed. ETSB was notified that St. Clair County has been awarded a reimbursement grant of \$972,509.00 which offsets 75% of the County's expenses. ETSB will be able to apply again in a few years to request reimbursement for the other half of our NG 9-1-1 system as those expenses are being paid monthly and we must have made the expense prior to requesting reimbursement.

Air Conditioner Replacement: Director Simmons informed the ETSB Board that Beloman is finishing the installation of the air conditioner in the ETSB server room.

Scott Air Force Base Cutover to State 9-1-1 Network: Director Simmons notified the ETSB Board that the secondary PSAPs at Scott Air Force Base Fire and Security Forces completed their cutover to the Statewide 9-1-1 network on August 5, 2024. All St. Clair County PSAPs now rely on the state next generation 9-1-1 network.
