October 2024 / November 2024

- 1. All monthly radio tests were conducted, and no problems were noted.
- Monthly tests of the outdoor warning sirens were completed.
- 3. Attend the monthly Conference call with IEMA Director regarding COVID-19
- 4. Attended the Monthly Starcom 21 Committee Meeting
- 5. Attended the STARRS Board Meeting.
- 6. Attended the Statewide Interoperable Executive Committee Meeting.
- 7. Attended meeting of the Statewide 9-1-1 Advisory Board.
- 8. Attended the monthly meeting of the St. Clair Special Emergency Services.
- Siren Vendor Engineer will be in St. Clair County on 11/20-11/21 beginning the final
 punch list to complete the siren project. St Clair County staff and Installer staff will be
 meeting with them to review any final items that need to be completed along with
 visual review of all sirens for warranty start.
- Bi-weekly meetings continue with the FEMA BRIC Staff to develop the project application for St. Clair County and the 11 eligible communities. The application deadline is January 2025.
- 11. Attend monthly meeting of the Long Term Recovery Division of our County COAD (Community Organization Active in Disaster).
- 12. Working with IEMA and FEMA to continue the buyout program. Awaiting the next step of the process. IEMA has determined 37 of the homes that applied for buyout are located in a "special flood hazard area" which will allow expediting their process and that is underway.
- 13. Federal Disaster recovery centers remain open in Cahokia and East St Louis. As of 11/15/2024 below is a summary of assistance provided in St. Clair County:
 - a. 8,946 residents registered for assistance
 - b. 8,466 property inspections scheduled
 - c. 6,493 property inspections completed
 - d. \$23,241,692.29 awarded in Individual Assistance
 - e. \$11,596,474.40 awarded in Housing Assistance
 - f. \$11,645,217.89 awarded in Other Needs Assistance
