This would negatively impact the monthly surcharge checks received by the ETSBs. After much opposition was voiced, a vote to decline the increase passed.

Director Simmons informed the ETSB Board that the Statewide 9-1-1 Advisory Board Administrator, Cindy Barbera-Brelle has announced her retirement.

Director Simmons mentioned a letter of commendation from Sheriff Watson recognizing CENCOM telecommunicators Roberta Seitz, Toni Fritz, and Tina Otten for their work in handling an incident on October 3, 2024.

Director Simmons led a discussion regarding a new telecommunicator training program that will be implemented by the ETSB staff. The specifics are still being discussed, and it will be presented to the ETSB Board soon.
