Per the St. Clair County EMA Report, Herb Simmons presented the following,

- 1. All monthly radio tests were conducted, and no problems were noted.
- 2. Monthly tests of the outdoor warning sirens were completed. Report of a siren malfunction in Shiloh that was investigated by the vendor and fixed.
- 3. Attend the monthly Conference call with IEMA Director regarding COVID-19
- 4. Attended the Monthly Starcom 21 Committee Meeting
- 5. Attended the STARRS Board Meeting.
- 6. Attended the Statewide Interoperable Executive Committee Meeting.
- 7. Attended meeting of the Statewide 9-1-1 Advisory Board.
- 8. Attended the monthly meeting of the St. Clair Special Emergency Services.
- 9. Finalizing the remaining 7 warning siren installations.
- 10. Bi-weekly meetings continue with the FEMA BRIC Staff to develop the project application for St. Clair County and the 11 eligible communities. The application deadline is January 2025.
- 11. Attend monthly meeting of the Long Term Recovery Division of our County COAD (Community Organization Active in Disaster).
- 12. Working with IEMA and FEMA to continue the buyout program. Awaiting the next step of the process. IEMA advises FEMA has been placed in Immediate Needs Funding due to too many active disasters and therefore anything not related to an ongoing disaster is placed on hold.
- 13. EMA staff participated in the INDY Race Series at World Wide Technology Raceway.
- 14. Command Post was deployed to assist at O'Fallon City Fest and Belleville Oktoberfest.
- 15. EMA Staff attended the annual IEMA Training Summit.

### ST. CLAIR COUNTY SHERIFF DEPARTMENT

Lt. Colonel Thomas Knapp reported the following for the month of August 01, 2024, ending August 31, 2024, which included the following data: Average Daily Population was 413, inmates admitted 604 of those 162 were females, 442 males, 197 misdemeanors, 285 felons, 10 Federal, 0 Transcor, and 79 fugitives. Sentence Weekend Bookings 20, Sentence County Bookings 2, D.O.C. 10, and Other 1. There were 75 traffic citations, 28 traffic warnings, 58 felony/misdemeanors/warrant arrests, 404 park patrol, 792 business checks, and 21 courthouse checks, for a total of 1092 points of contact with the general public.
