Lt. Colonel Thomas Knapp reported the following for the month of March 01, 2025, ending March 31, 2025, which included the following data: Average Daily Population was 439, inmates admitted 677 of those 188 were females, 489 were males, 219 misdemeanors, 297 felons, 8 Federal, 111 fugitives, and 0 Transcor. Sentence Weekend Bookings 14, Sentence County Bookings 7, D.O.C. 16 and Other 5. There were 121 traffic citations, 143 traffic warnings, 32 felony/misdemeanors/warrant arrests, 459 park patrols, 1092 business checks, and 31 courthouse checks, for a total of 983 points of contact with the general public.

Per the St. Clair County EMA Report Herb Simmons presented the following,

1. All monthly radio tests were conducted, and no problems were noted. The backup microwave link between St Louis and St. Clair County was damaged in recent storms and crews will be out the week of 4/21/25 to assess and repair. At this time, it is not system impacting as it only serves as a redundant link.
2. Monthly tests of the outdoor warning sirens were completed, and issues were detected with the Sirens at Camp Jackson Firehouse and Fayetteville. Replacement parts are ordered under warranty and the manufacturer will deploy a crew to install as soon as the parts arrive.

4. Attended the STARRS Board Meeting.
5. Attended the Statewide Interoperable Executive Committee Meeting.
6. Attended meeting of the Statewide 9-1-1 Advisory Board.
