Sentence Weekend Bookings 15, Sentence County Bookings 6, D.O.C. 7 and Other 5. There were 132 traffic citations, 146 traffic warnings, 53 felony/misdemeanors/warrant arrests, 480 park patrols, 1214 business checks, and 36 courthouse checks, for a total of 1129 points of contact with the general public.
