Report of Activities **Emergency Readiness / Public Safety Committee** **May 2025/ June 2025**

Per the St. Clair County EMA Report Herb Simmons presented the following.

1. All monthly radio tests were conducted, and no problems were noted.
2. Monthly tests of the outdoor warning sirens were completed, and all sirens functioned as expected.
3. Attended the Monthly Starcom 21 Committee Meeting
4. Attended the STARRS Board Meeting.
5. Attended the Statewide Interoperable Executive Committee Meeting.
6. Attended meeting of the Statewide 9-1-1 Advisory Board.
7. Attended the monthly meeting of the St. Clair Special Emergency Services.
8. Siren vender completed their warrant inspection of the sirens and all passed. One siren in Cahokia Heights has been vandalized twice since its installation and we are working with Village officials to determine an alternate location prior to re-installing additional equipment.
9. Attend monthly meeting of the Long-Term Recovery Division of our County COAD (Community Organization Active in Disaster).
10. Command Post Deployed to the Fairgrounds to support staff relocation during construction efforts.
11. Staff assisted with event coordination and safety monitoring of the Bommarito 500 Weekend with Worldwide Technology Raceway.
12. Staff participated in Veterans Administration exercise hosted at St Louis Downtown Airport.
13. Staff attended mass fatality tabletop exercise with the regional partners from STARRS.

ST. CLAIR COUNTY SHERIFF DEPARTMENT

Lt. Colonel Thomas Knapp reported the following for the month of May 01, 2025, ending May 31, 2025, which included the following data: Average Daily Population was 432, inmates admitted 610 of those 179 were females, 431 were males, 215 misdemeanors, 258 felons, 3 Federal, 86 fugitives, and 0 Transcor. Sentence Weekend Bookings 31, Sentence County Bookings 2, D.O.C. 13 and Other 2. There were 109 traffic citations, 76 traffic warnings, 40 felony/misdemeanors/warrant arrests, 450 park patrols, 1392 business checks, and 20 courthouse checks, for a total of 1027 points of contact with the general public.
